**Brief Outline of Major Issues to be made Regarding this Subject:**

- The Universe exhibition is the largest collaboration of exhibitions ever in the history of Pasadena. It includes eight leading Pasadena area institutions: Armory Center for the Arts, Art Center College of Design, Caltech, Huntington Library, Norton Simon Museum, One Colorado, Pacific Asia Museum, and Southwest Chamber Music. Each of the institutions' exhibitions focus on a specific area around the theme of the universe.
- This collaboration is an achievement that you might expect from a city the size of New York or Chicago. That it's happened here is a great reflection on our city.
- The City of Pasadena has supported this innovative exhibition through its City of Pasadena Cultural Affair Division and Pasadena Arts Commission through its Arts and Culture grants program. The Pasadena In Focus newsletter has also written about it. The Public Affairs Office supported our publicity efforts.
- The exhibition has been widely publicized in Southern California, with mailings to half a million households. Soon there will also be pole banners waving throughout Los Angeles county for a three-month period to bring new visitors to Pasadena.
- We would like to give Universe exhibition catalogues to each of the City Council members, to the City Manager, City Attorney and the City Clerk. We would also like to extend an invitation to each of you, if you have not already visited our exhibitions, to bring your family and friends to join us in this historic event.
