AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON HOURS OF OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR A PERMITTED EVENT AT VICTORY PARK FOR

SPECIFIED HOURS ON SUNDAY, MARCH 31, 2002.

TITLE OF THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON HOURS OF OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR A PERMITTED EVENT AT VICTORY PARK FOR SPECIFIED HOURS ON SUNDAY, MARCH 31, 2002.

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:

This proposed ordinance will suspend the Noise Ordinance for a permitted event at Victory Park during specified hours on Sunday, March 31, 2002 as to general noise and amplified sound. The enactment of this proposed ordinance is needed for this event to take place.

This event was approved by the City Council at its meeting held February 4, 2002.

REASON WHY LEGISLATON IS NEEDED:

The Noise Ordinance was enacted by ordinance and can only be suspended by an ordinance of the City Council.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

Any City costs that may be incurred for this event (i.e., sound meter reading, park clean up, etc.) are to be paid by the event promoter.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT:

The Environmental Administrator has determined that the Temporary Use Permit and the ordinance necessary to hold this non-profit event are categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines Section 15323, Normal Operations of Facilities for Public Gatherings. This action to allow an Easter Sunrise Service is normal operation for public gatherings in Victory Park.
