**PROPERTY SETBACKS - trees, aesthetics, vistas, air quality..**

- 1) Apparent height of building is inversely proportional to setback.**

- 4) Exposure to noise and carbon monoxide are higher when occupancy is right next to street.**
- 5) Trees and other plant photosynthesis is essential for oxygen supply.**
