## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council reject all bids for Providing Labor and Materials for Deep Well and Pump Maintenance for the Water and Power Department, Specification WD-02-01.

## BACKGROUND


Specification WD-02-01 (Specification) for Providing Labor and Materials for Deep Well and Pump Maintenance for the Water and Power Department was issued on July 11, 2002. Three responses were received and opened in the City Clerk's Office on July 31, 2002.

Subsequent to the bid opening, it was determined that the Specification was confusing for some of the bidders in regards to Bid Item Number 18, Lump Sum for Invoiced Items. Accordingly, rather than recommend the award of a contract at this time, staff recommends that the City Council reject all bids. Staff will revise the Specification to clarify Bid Item Number 18 and reissue the bid.


FISCAL IMPACT

The cost of reissuing and rebidding the Specification is negligible.


