INTRODUCTED BY COUNCILMEMBER

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA FIXING THE FY 2003 TAX RATE FOR THE POLICE BUILDING AND JAIL GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR COLLECTION AND ENFORCEMENT OF SAID TAX

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Pasadena, California (the "City") adopted on July 27, 1987 Resolution No. 5815, as amended by Resolution On. 5831 adopted on August 17, 1987 (collectively, the "Resolution"), which Resolution authorizes, among other things, the issuance and sale of \$17,000,000 principal amount of City of Pasadena 1987 Police Building and Jail general Obligation Bonds (the "Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 905 of the Charter of the City and Section 43632 of the Government Code of the State of California, the City Council of the City is required to fix, by ordinance, on or before the first Monday in September in each year, the tax rate and establish procedures for tax collection and enforcement, and to fix a tax rate which will raise sufficient moneys, when added to all other estimated income and revenue, to pay, among other things, the interest and sinking funds for outstanding funded debt which will become due before the proceeds of a tax levied at the next general tax levy will be available.

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

Section 1. All of the recitals herein are true and correct.

Section 2. The tax rate required to be levied for fiscal year 2003 in order to raise sufficient moneys, when added to all other estimated income and revenue, to pay, among other things, the interest and sinking funds for outstanding funded debt which will become due before the proceeds of a tax levied at the next general tax levy will be available is \$.014611 per \$100 of assessed valuation.
