


In adopting a modified parking ordinance, the City Council is authorizing the conditional parking on public streets and public parking lots within close proximity to events and also the search, under voluntary consent, of any vehicles to be parked within the restricted area. Vehicle owners who refuse to a voluntary vehicle search would be required to move their vehicle out of the restricted area. Those that do not consent and do not choose to move their vehicle would face vehicle impoundment for ordinance violation.

Additionally, vehicles that are left unattended and have not been contacted by a representative of the Police Department may be searched, impounded and/or towed at the owner's expense. Parking restrictions and conditions will be plainly posted in all restricted areas.

FISCAL IMPACT


There is no direct fiscal impact from the approval of this recommendation. Should City Council approve the modification of the Pasadena Municipal Code, it is estimated that the cost for signs and postings will be approximately \$10,000 per year. Sufficient funding exists within the City's Special Events account (8011 105 406 011) to cover this expense.
