NOVEMBER 2, 2003 (RACE FOR THE CURE)

TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO AN EXEMPTION FROM THE NOISE ORDINANCE FOR A PERMITTED EVENT AT AREA H AND THE ARROYO SECO FOR SPECIFIED HOURS ON SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2003.

<u>PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:</u> This proposed ordinance is to suspend the Noise Ordinance for the permitted event at Area H and the Arroyo Seco as follows: 1.) Race for the Cure to be held at Area H and the Arroyo Seco on Sunday, November 2, 2003 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The enactment of the proposed ordinance is needed for the event to have amplified sound prior to 10:00 a.m.

The suspension of the Noise Ordinance for this event was approved by the City Council at its meeting of July 23, 2003.

<u>REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:</u> The Noise Ordinance was enacted by ordinance and can only be suspended by the enactment of an ordinance.

<u>FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:</u> Any City costs that may be incurred (i.e., sound monitoring, park clean up, etc.) Are to be paid by the non-profit organization.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT: The environmental administrator has determined that the proposed suspension of the noise ordinance necessary to hold the non-profit event is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA guidelines Section 15323, Normal Operations of Facilities for Public Gatherings.
