<u>TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:</u> AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING CHAPTER 5.24 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO THE ASSESSMENT OF A FEE FOR FALSE ALARMS

<u>PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:</u> The purpose of the Ordinance is to amend the way fees for false alarms are assessed. The amendment would allow the imposition of a fee upon the occurrence of the second and any subsequent false alarms. Currently, fees are assessed upon the fourth and subsequent occurrence of a false alarm. The amendment would allow the Police Department to recover costs for services related to false alarm responses, as well encourage the prevention of false alarms

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED: Currently fees for false alarms are regulated by ordinance. An ordinance is therefore needed to amend these regulations. At its June 30, 2003, City Council meeting, the Council directed preparation of an ordinance to amend the basis for assessing fees for false alarms.

<u>PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENT OR GROUPS AFFECTED:</u> The Police Department and Finance Department will be responsible for enforcing the regulations and collecting the fees.

ENVIRONMENTAL: This ordinance is categorically exempt from CEQA under Guideline 15308.

<u>FISCAL IMPLICATIONS</u>: Approval of the ordinance amendment will result in an increase to the General Fund in an amount estimated to be \$126,524.

<u>POLICY CHANGES:</u> This ordinance creates a new policy regarding the collection of fees for false alarms by charging the fee beginning with the second false alarm instead of the fourth false alarm.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING CHAPTER 5.24 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO THE ASSESSMENT OF A FEE FOR FALSE ALARMS		
WHEREAS, police response to false burglar alarms increases costs to and impacts the		
efficiency of the police department; and		
WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Pasadena desires to prevent such false		
alarms and provide the ability to recoup the cost of responding to false alarms.		
NOW THEREFORE, the people of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:		
SECTION 1. Section 5.24.130 subsection A of Chapter 5.24 is hereby amended to read		
as follows:		
A. The director of finance, upon the occurrence of the second and any		
subsequent false alarm during any 12 month period, shall assess a fee on		
the permittee as adopted from time to time by resolution of the city council		
of the city.		
SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon the expiration of thirty days from its		
publication.
