## TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

AN UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON HOURS OF OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR SPECIFIED HOURS AND AREAS ON MAY 14 & 15, 2004 (WANGO TANGO CONCERT).

#### PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:

This proposed ordinance is to provide a suspension of the Noise Ordinance as to general noise and amplified sound which will allow for a sound check from 12:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Friday, May 14, 2004 and Saturday, May 15, 2004 from 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. for sound check and the presentation of a concert pursuant to a license agreement with the Rose Bowl Operating Company for the "Wango Tango" event. This proposed ordinance is required for the event to take place.

The City Council approved this event at its meeting of February 23, 2004 and directed the preparation of this ordinance.

#### REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:

The Noise Ordinance was enacted by ordinance and can only be suspended by an ordinance of the City Council.

# **FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:**

It is anticipated that this event will result in a net profit to the RBOC of approximately \$168,000.

## **ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT:**

The Master Environmental Impact Report for the Arroyo Seco Master Plan analyzes potential impacts that could result from 25 events at the Rose Bowl. The City Council certified the MEIR for the Arroyo Seco Master Plan on April 14, 2003. The project is consistent with the environmental analysis in the MEIR.

Suspending Sections 9.36.220 (amplification sound regulations) and 9.36.230 (general noise sources) of the Noise Restrictions Ordinance of the Pasadena Municipal Code is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under CEQA Guidelines Section 15323 Normal Operations of Facilities for Public Gatherings.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.
