Dear Mayor Bogaard:

With regard to the staff presentation given to the City Council on Monday, November 15, 2004, several Transportation Advisory Commissioners have shown interest in providing input for the Arroyo Parkway Streetscape Enhancement Project. There are many aspects of the plan that compelled the commissioners to contact me concerned that TAC had not reviewed the plan in the forum of a public hearing, and that TAC could have valuable input with regard to mobility issues including pedestrians, bicycles and transit.

I contacted Transportation Staff to post TAC's review of the Project as an Action Item on our December agenda. The meeting is scheduled for Friday, December 3, 2004 at 7:30 a.m. Staff put me in contact with Martin Pastucha, Director of Public Works, who informed me that because the Project had already been presented to the City Council, it would require a referral from the Council for Public Works staff to provide their presentation to the TAC for comment.

Is it the City Council's request that the project be referred to TAC and that City Staff present the Project to TAC who will in turn provide comments and/or recommendations to the City Council for their consideration? Also, if so, would it be possible for the City Council to consider this request at the City Council Meeting on Monday, November 22, 2004 so staff would have adequate time to prepare for our December meeting?
