SUBJECT:

APPROVAL OF THE 2003-2004 ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT OF THE OLD

PASADENA MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council approve the Annual Financial Report (Attachment A) of the Old Pasadena Management District ("OPMD") for the Old Pasadena Property and Business Improvement District.

BACKGROUND:

General

In May 2000 the Old Pasadena Business & Professional Association formally converted to the Old Pasadena Management District as a Property and Business Improvement District (PBID) in a move to become a more effective body in maintaining Old Pasadena's competitiveness as a regional destination.

On June 26, 2000 City Council through the Business Enterprise Committee (BEC) approved the OPMD, and adopted a funding plan for the OPMD committing \$545,000 per year in financial support.

Conditions to Funding

Council authorized the City Manager to enter into the Baseline Services Contract and Agreement for Services conveying the City's financial support. The Agreement for Services specifies conditions that OPMD must meet. The Annual Plan describes activities that occurred over the 2003 operational year and the 2004 operating goals and objectives (Attachment B).

The City's Finance Director has affirmed that OPMD has complied with all conditions for the use of funds as specified in the Agreement for Administrative Funds.

Use of Funds

The Agreement for Administrative Funds allocated \$545,000 from revenue collected from the Old Pasadena Parking Meter Fund, the Old Pasadena Parking Structure Fund, and Old Pasadena redevelopment tax increment funds and specified how all City contributions were to be utilized. These funds represent levels of funding commitment and payments in lieu of the district property assessments on city-owned properties.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The City's annual contribution to the OPMD is \$545,000. The annual contribution for fiscal year 2004 has been programmed in the FY 04 Operating Budget. Future contributions during the term of the agreement will be included in subsequent recommended budgets.
