TITLE OF THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO AN EXEMPTION FROM THE NOISE ORDINANCE FOR A PERMITTED EVENT AT HAHAMONGNA WATERSHED PARK FOR SPECIFIED HOURS ON SUNDAY, JUNE 13, 2004 (MIKE ANTONOVICH TRAIL RIDE)

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:

This proposed ordinance is to suspend the Noise Ordinance for a permitted event at Hahamongna Watershed Park on Sunday, June 13, 2004 from 8 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. The enactment of this proposed ordinance is needed for the event to have amplified sound prior to 10:00 a.m.

An agenda report for this meeting seeks direction to prepare this ordinance.

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:

The Noise Ordinance was enacted by ordinance and can only be suspended by an ordinance of the City Council.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

Any City costs that may be incurred (i.e., sound meter reading, park clean up, etc.) are to be paid by the non-profit agency.


ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT:

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 9.36.220 and 9.36.230 of the Pasadena Municipal Code are hereby suspended from the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. on June 13, 2004 for an event at Hahamongna Watershed Park for which there is a City Special Event permit in force and effect.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause this ordinance to be published in full text.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.
