AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING CHAPTER 4.08 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE, THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND PURCHASING ORDINANCE, INCREASING THE AMOUNT AT WHICH EMERGENCY PURCHASES ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FROM \$25,000 TO \$75,000.

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 4.08.150 of the Pasadena Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“4.08.150 Emergency purchases.

In case of actual emergency which requires immediate purchase of material or services, the director of finance or his authorized representative with the approval of the city manager may secure without competitive bidding, at the lowest obtainable price, any material or services regardless of the amount of the expenditure. A full report of the circumstances of any such emergency purchase shall be filed with the city manager, and, where the expenditure exceeds \$75,000, with the city council.”

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause this ordinance to be published in full text.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.
