SUBJECT: Adopt a Resolution setting a date for Public Hearing to consider the Establishment of Underground Utility District No. 04-2 Hill Avenue (Villa Street to North City Limit)

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that City Council adopt a resolution setting a date for a public hearing to consider the formation of Underground Utility District No. 04-2 on October 25, 2004.

## BACKGROUND

The City has a continuing program to underground all overhead electric systems, specifically communication and power lines. The undergrounding of overhead electric systems improves system reliability and the aesthetic quality of an area is enhanced by the removal of unsightly utility poles and overhead wires. Although the affected utilities are currently preparing draft plans for the undergrounding system, an established underground utility district is necessary to require the affected property owners to underground their private property facilities.

A finding of compliance with the General Plan was previously made and this project is shown in the adopted fiscal year (FY) 2005 Capital Improvement Program. It is recommended that the City proceed with formation of this underground district.

The initial step in the creation of an Underground Utility District is for the City Council to conduct a public hearing to ascertain whether or not the change from an overhead to an underground electric system is in the public interest. Detailed information pertaining to the establishment of the district will be presented at the hearing. The City Clerk will notify all affected utilities and affected property owners of the time and place of the hearing.

A meeting between various City staff, public utilities and the affected property owners within the proposed district is scheduled for Monday, October 11, 2004 to permit property owners an opportunity to discuss matters pertaining to the proposed utility district and be fully informed of their responsibility under Chapter 13.14 of the Pasadena Municipal Code entitled Underground Utility Districts.

#### RESOLUTION NO.

#### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASADENA CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING TO DETERMINE WHETHER PUBLIC NECESSITY, HEALTH, SAFETY, OR WELFARE REQUIRES THE FORMATION OF AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT ON HILL AVENUE FROM VILLA STREET TO NORTH CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, Chapter 13.14 of the Pasadena Municipal Code establishes a procedure for the creation of underground utility districts and requires as the initial step in each procedure the holding of a public hearing to ascertain whether public necessity, health, safety, or welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communications, or similar or associated service in any such district; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Pasadena that:

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the City Council of the City of Pasadena on October 25, 2004 at 8:00 p.m. in the Pasadena Senior Center, Multi-purpose Room located at 85 E. Holly Street, Pasadena, California, to ascertain whether the public necessity health, safety, or welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communications, or similar associated service in the District hereinabove described.

2. Such hearing shall be open to the public and all interested persons may appear whether in person or by agent and shall be heard. Said hearing may be continued from time to time as may be determined by the City Council.

3. The City Clerk shall notify all affected utilities and affected property owners, as shown on the real property records of the County Assessor, Tax and License Collector, of the time and place of such hearing by mailing a copy of this resolution and a cover letter prepared by the Public Works Department, to such utilities and property owners at least 10 days prior to the date thereof. 4. The area proposed to be included in the District is shown upon City of Pasadena Public Works Department Drawing No. 5338, Sheets 1 entitled "Underground Utility District No. 04-2, Hill Avenue from Villa Street to North City Limit", a copy of which hereby is filed in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Pasadena.
