SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that City Council terminate the Declaration of a Local Emergency initially issued February 28, 2005, and reissued on March 7, 2005.

SUMMARY

On March 14, 2005, City Council adopted a resolution ratifying the City Manager's Declaration of a Local Emergency. In accordance with Government Code 8630, the City Council must review the existence of the local emergency at least once every 14 days until the local emergency has been terminated. The purpose of this Agenda Report is to provide Council the opportunity to terminate the local emergency. Based on current and forecasted conditions, termination of the Declaration of Local Emergency is appropriate.

BACKGROUND

Pursuant to Chapter 2.370 of the Pasadena Municipal Code, the City Manager, as the Director of Emergency Services, issued a Declaration of Local Emergency on February 28, 2005. A quorum of the Council was unable to meet within the required seven days to ratify the Declaration and the Director of Emergency Services issued a second Declaration, on March 7, 2005. In accordance with Government Code 8630, the City Council must review the existence of the local emergency at least once every 14 days until the local emergency has been terminated, and requires the City Council to proclaim the termination of the local emergency at the earliest possible date that conditions warrant.

FISCAL IMPACT

This action has no negative fiscal impact.
