
FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

There is no fiscal impact associated with this amendment, other than the cost associated with changing the name on commission stationery, business cards, and signs.


POLICY CHANGE:

This amendment does not represent a policy change by the City Council, but is merely intended to reflect more accurately the functions of this advisory body.



**ORDINANCE NO.** \_\_\_\_\_

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING TITLE 2,  
CHAPTER 2.47 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE TO CHANGE THE  
NAME OF THE “ARTS COMMISSION” TO THE “ARTS AND CULTURE  
COMMISSION”**

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The chapter heading of Chapter 2.47 in Title 2 of the Pasadena  
Municipal Code(“Arts Commission”) is amended to read:

“Chapter 2.47

**ARTS AND CULTURE COMMISSION”.**

**SECTION 2.** Section 2.47.010 of the Pasadena Municipal Code is hereby amended to  
read:

“2.47.010 Short title.

This chapter shall be known as the “arts and culture commission  
ordinance.”

**SECTION 3.** Section 2.47.020 of the Pasadena Municipal Code is hereby amended to  
read:

“The city recognizes the performing and fine arts as a profession, essential to  
human needs and which enhance the city’s physical beauty, economic health and quality of  
life.
