PROJECTED NFL IMPACT OF 1 or 2 MONDAY OR THURSDAY NIGHT GAMES ON ORGANIZED SPORTS/RELATED EVENTS:

Use of Area H on Fall evenings is primarily for youth sports practices (primarily youth soccer and youth football), which in Sept./Oct. end by 5:30 pm (prior to 6pm NFL use start time, so no projected impact). In later Fall, portable lights are permitted on Area H, allowing later practices (to 9pm), so if a Mon. or Thurs. NFL fell in later Fall, the youth sports practices would end at 5:30pm on game day. In Brookside Park, the City adult softball league (Major League Softball) plays two games per weeknight on two ball diamonds, so 4 games would require rescheduling; if on a Thursday, Pasadena Dog Obedience class (7-8pm) would be rescheduled.
