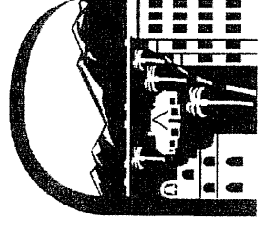
Overview of the San Gabriel Valley

- 2 Million LA County Residents
- 31 incorporated cities and several unincorporated communities stretching over an area of 980 square miles
- 66,000 business employers with more than 750,000 employees
- 550,000 Households
- Ethnically diverse: 44% Latino, 26% White, 22% Asian, 4% Black, and 2% Multi-racial
- Seven of the region's freeways cross the through the Valley



Did You Know?

- ✓ 19% of LA County's population lives in the San Gabriel Valley
- ✓ 17% of LA County's jobs are in the San Gabriel Valley
- ✓ 35% of LA County's incorporated cities are in the San Gabriel Valley
- ✓ 33% of LA County's unincorporated residents live in the San Gabriel Valley
- ✓ The San Gabriel Valley is represented by 3 LA County supervisors, 13 members of the State Legislature, and by 5 members of US Congress
- ✓ In the 1990's, 2 out of every 3 new jobs created in LA County were in the San Gabriel Valley
- ✓ By the year 2030, the San Gabriel Valley will add 620,000 people, 190,000 households, and 200,000 jobs
- ✓ The San Gabriel Valley is currently 99% built out



San Gabriel Valley Population

- Over twice the size of San Francisco City/County, the City of San Jose, and Ventura County
- Roughly the size of San Bernardino and Riverside Counties
- Larger than 12 States, with a population approximately the size of Nevada, New Mexico, and West Virginia
