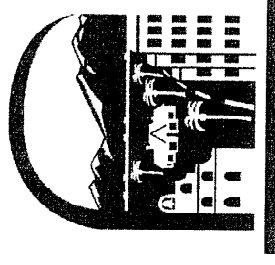
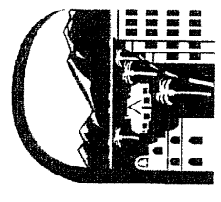
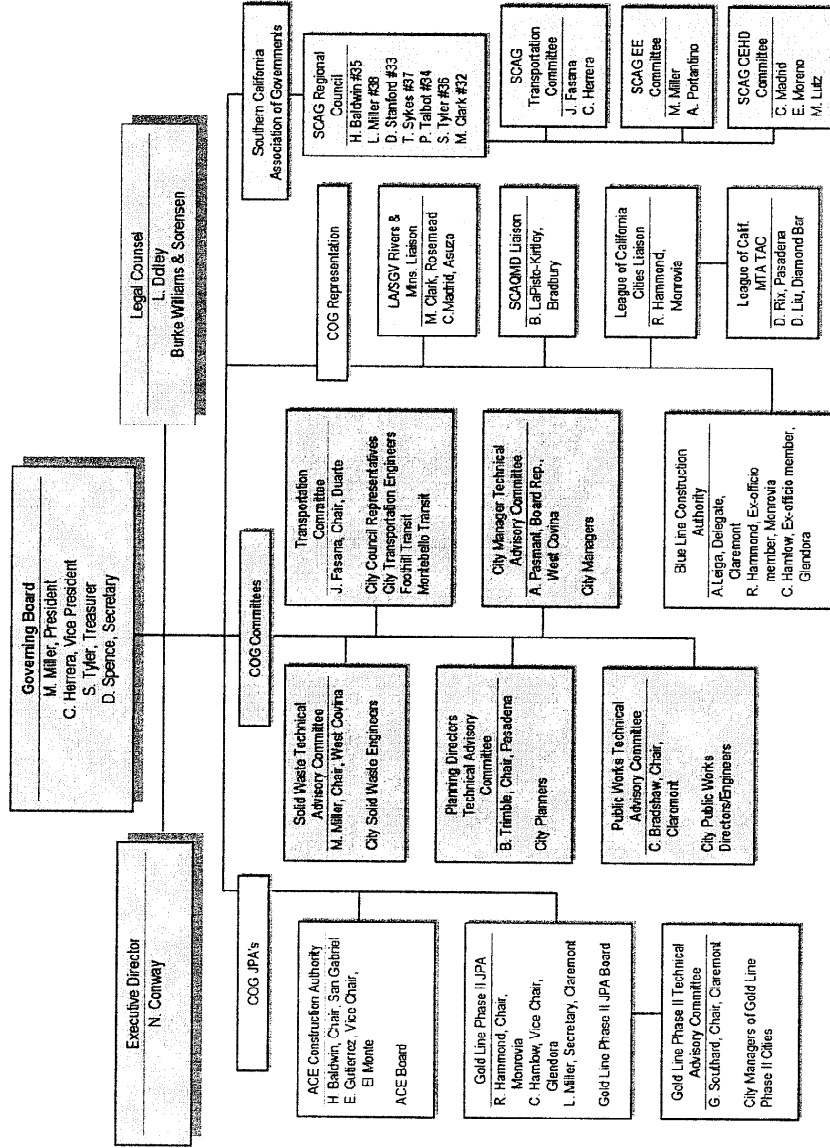


## SGVCOG Mission

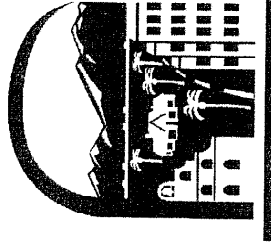
# SGVCOG Organizational Structure

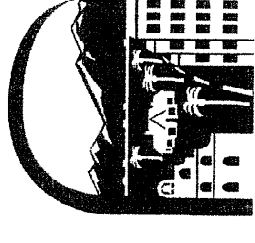

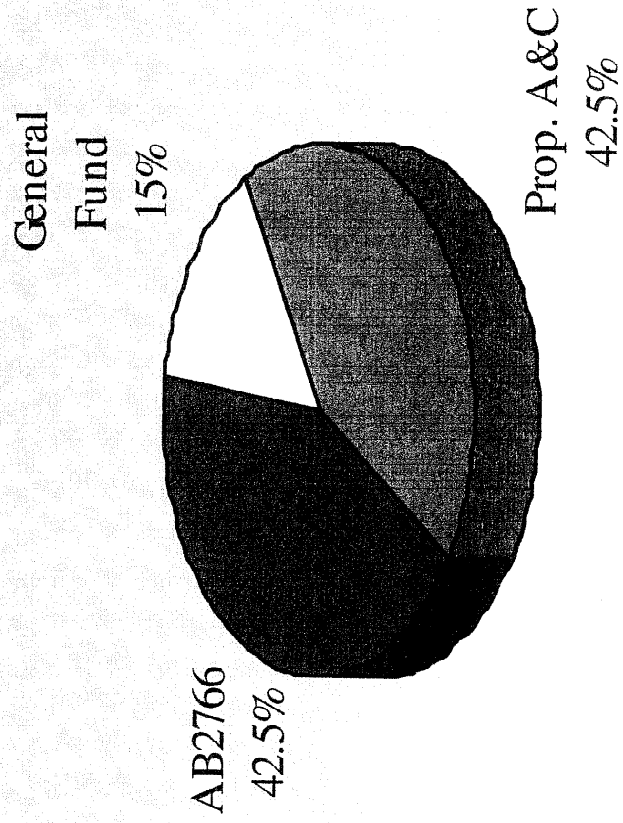

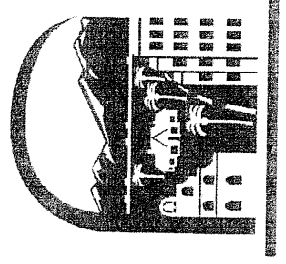




# Membership & Dues Revenue
