

I watched the Council meeting last night, and was struck by the polarization of the public comments. On one side were concerns about quality of life and aesthetics, on the other concerns about money.

Joel Sheldon presented the money arguments better than most -- I was impressed by his rhetorical skill, but was not sold.

The Rose Bowl was created as a civic contribution, for a specific purpose: college football. It has never been a profit center for the city, and should not be. If it is not competitive as an arena, we are better off since the negative impact of use as an arena is avoided. If it becomes unusable, it can still serve as a historic landmark -- even in advanced decay, the Roman Coliseum is an attraction.

The NFL has an abysmal track record as a long-term tenant -- witness the peregrinations of the Raiders. We are better off avoiding a partnership with them.

Cut off the dance now. Reject the incomplete and hurried EIR. Keep Pasadena for Pasadenans.

Since public comment is extended for another week, I would like to make additional comment for the benefit of the City Council.
Thank you.

Dear Mayor and City Councilpersons,

If the Rose Bowl is in dire straights and depends upon dramatic change from the status quo to maintain its viability, whether in the form of the NFL or some other “solution”, then another alternative must be considered in the EIR, namely a structured disengagement from contractual and financial commitments and the decommissioning and demolition of the Rose Bowl. The current EIR considers maintaining the status quo as an alternative. However, if maintaining the status quo proves to not be a viable alternative (as the Rose Bowl Operating Committee suggests), then it is only logical that the alternative of removing the Rose Bowl be considered and evaluated. In this way the City could consider another avenue for solving a financial dilemma.

The Rose Bowl Operating Committee suggests that the only viable “savior” of the Rose Bowl is the NFL, and if that fails a major investment of City money would be required, which it says would be untenable. If in fact the Rose Bowl is a dinosaur that must be upgraded to survive, then it makes every good bit of sense to consider the alternative of pulling the plug.

Consideration of this alternative could give clearer focus to the question of whether the Rose Bowl might indeed survive after all, without becoming a massive development opportunity to advocates of its reconstruction.

A focus on this alternative would create other opportunities, namely to (i) address the shortage of open space and parks and recreation facilities for our citizens, (ii) study in a more comprehensive way the removal of the channel and restoration of the Arroyo, and (iii) consider improving traffic, noise, air quality and the like by emphasizing the Arroyo as a resource for local use rather than a magnet for tens of thousands of people to come to our City from the outside for regular events.

Failure to consider this alternative seems to me to be a failure of the EIR, as well a lost opportunity to really think progressively about the future use of the Arroyo as a resource for our community for generations to come.

There are many factors that can make a city great; affordable, quality public golf courses are one such factor. I am a Pasadena resident and an avid golfer at Brookside Golf Club. Brookside offers two good courses at a fair price. As I understand it, Brookside is also very profitable for Pasadena.

Right now, the number of annual Rose Bowl events is at a level that does not overly deny golfers the ability to play nor tear up the golf courses too much. However, refurbishing the Rose Bowl to accommodate an NFL franchise as well as 10+ (pre season and regular season) NFL games per season will seriously impair Brookside and all the golfers who play there. **For that reason, I am opposed to an NFL franchise at the Rose Bowl.**

Dear Steve:

It is my understanding that you are supporting the idea of having an NFL team in the Rose Bowl along with all the immense changes to the stadium and the area around the Rose Bowl that such a decision would require. As a resident of Pasadena since 1963 and a South Arroyo Blvd resident since 1968, I feel qualified to speak to the negative effects of such a decision. And I speak not as a NIMBY but as someone who can speak to the negative effects on the city and the surrounding region as whole.

Although I am a pro football fan, I feel that the NFL owners hold cities hostage to their demands --"Build us a new stadium or we will leave the city" or "Build us a new expensive state of the art stadium or we will not choose you for a new team site". I do not trust their promises of economic gain for the city nor that their monetary demands will not increase at a later time. Take Seattle's experience for example-- Paul Allen of Microsoft fame promised to build a new stadium at no taxpayer expense (I don't remember which sport this was for) but the citizens ended up being taxed for a major shortfall. I do not feel that the Arroyo and the Rose Bowl should be used for this major commercial expansion. A stadium should be built near freeways with no impact on neighborhoods or pristine natural and recreational areas.

The Rose Bowl sits in a very unique location -- both residential and recreational. What a loss to Pasadena, Altadena and surrounding cities if the following are locked out of the Brookside and Rose Bowl areas at least one weekend day if not two for the months of August to January: Golfers, AYSO soccer, tennis players, joggers, cyclists, walkers, picnikers, visitors to the new Kid Space Museum, Aquatic Center users, horseback riders and hikers. I had breakfast this morning at Brookside and in looking in the large photo of the Rose Bowl there tried to envision the footprint a new massive stadium and related commercial stores, etc. would have.

I can speak to the tremendous impact of traffic and air pollution from Rose Bowl game traffic from long experience. And this certainly has an impact overall on the whole city not just on the Southwest Pasadena neighborhoods. Traffic streams in hours before games and Pasadena has made no effort to mitigate problems before the event except for the New Year's game. For example, I once sat at 11:00 AM between Pasadena Ave. and St. Johns on California Blvd. for an hour and 15 minutes (before a 1:00 game), The problem -- no traffic control at Orange Grove or St. Johns--cars on Orange Grove heading north toward Rose Bowl blocked the intersection. Freeway traffic backed up -- impacting more than just the neighborhood. After large games, it takes 2 1/2 to 3 hours for the traffic to clear. How many shoppers and movie goers and those dining out stay away from Pasadena on game days? How much of that revenue is lost to businesses? As to air pollution, on the last Super Bowl event in the Rose Bowl, we returned from watching it in Santa Monica at 10 PM long after the game ended to find our yard and our house choked with auto exhaust -- it did not clear enough for us to open our windows and go to bed until midnight. Most attendees came in limos and by bus charters unlike most people coming to UCLA games. Store keepers, restaurant owners and Hotel people complained bitterly the next day that instead of a welcome blip in profits due to the game, they saw a loss of income as gamegoers headed back to other parts of Los Angeles.

Once again, this has an impact on all of Pasadena and not just one neighborhood. I could tell more neighborhood

horror stories -- for instance the time an elderly neighbor was returning to her home on California Terrace and had forgotten her resident pass.. The intersection guard refused to accept her drivers license ID. and in road rage smashed her driver side window showering her with glass when he thought she was not going to obey her, or the long wait at Orange Grove and Green hours before a game because the non police person traffic control at that intersection would not recognize our resident pass and stop traffic to let us through. How much extra would it cost Pasadena to provide adequate and experinced personnel to mitigate such severe traffic problems? How many more alcohol related accidents would occur following so many new games at the Bowl?

So I urge you to reconsider your position on the NFL. It is just not appropriate for Pasadena's prime recreational and natural area and not fair to impose such an extra burden on the surrounding residential areas. Nor is there any guarantee that the NFL's pie in the sky promises to benefit the whole city will actually happen. Without the idea of the NFL, Pasadena could creatively come up with other solutions to the Rose Bowl deficit as has been recently porposed in letters to the editor in the Star News---solutions that will benefit the whole city
