CONTRACT AWARD TO REPIPE - CALIFORNIA, INC. FOR SEWER

RELINING ON GREEN STREET AND OTHER LOCATIONS FOR AN

AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$190,000

## **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the City Council accept the bid, dated February 10, 2006, submitted by RePipe - California, Inc. for the Sewer Relining on Green Street and Other Locations, reject all other bids received, and authorize the City Manager to enter into such contract as is required.

## **BACKGROUND**

The project calls for the installation of 3,520 feet of pipe liner inside vitrified clay and cast iron sewer pipes on Green Street from Fair Oaks Avenue to Raymond Avenue, from El Molino Avenue to Hudson Avenue, and at other various sites in the City. A complete list of repair locations is included in this report as Exhibit "A".

The defective sewer pipes were identified through phases 1 and 2 of the five-year sewer televising program. Rehabilitation of the pipes will be accomplished with the insertion of pipe liner via the sewer manholes. There is no excavation required for this process, so the inconvenience to the public will be minimal. On those streets with high daytime vehicular traffic, or in pipes with heavy daytime sewer flow, the work will be done at night. This project is consistent with the Land Use Element by continuing to implement capital improvements which will maintain or rehabilitate infrastructure.

The Department of Public Works prepared Specifications for the subject project, and in Accordance with Section 4.08.070 of the Pasadena Municipal Code, bids have been requested and received. The project was advertised in the <u>Pasadena Journal</u> on January 19, 2006. In addition, the Notice Inviting Bids was published in four trade publications, listed on two web sites, and mailed out to sixty (60) potential bidders. Bid packets were obtained by six contractors, two of whom submitted bids for the project.

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Following advertising, bids were opened on February 10, 2006 and are as follows:

It is recommended that RePipe - California, Inc. be awarded the contract for this project as they are the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The proposed contract with RePipe - California, Inc. fully complies with the Competitive Bidding and Living Wage Ordinances. The Contractor has indicated that the award of this contract will result in zero new hires to his present workforce.

The prices received from the successful low bidder are lower than the estimated costs. It is proposed to use the cost savings from the low bid unit prices to install liners for additional sewer pipes. The attached Exhibit 'B' lists the additional lining locations which total approximately 2,000 feet. It is recommended that the contingency allowance for the project be set at 50 percent of the bid amount of \$ 126,700, or \$63,300, so that funds are available in the contract for the additional work. The proposed contract will be set up as follows:

It is anticipated that the project will begin in April 2006 and be completed in May 2006.
