AN UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220(B) AND 9.36.230(B)(9) OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON HOURS OF OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND FOR SPECIFIED HOURS AND AREAS ON MAY 5, 2006 (SOCCER MATCH FEATURING THE MEN'S NATIONAL TEAM OF MEXICO – HOURS OF OPERATION ONLY).

SECTION 1. The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

Sections 9.36.220(B) and 9.36.230(B)(9) of the Pasadena Municipal Code are suspended from the hours of 10:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on May 5, 2006, for an event at the Rose Bowl area for which a valid license agreement is in force and effect, but with respect to hours of operation, only, and not with respect to limitations on the maximum levels of amplified sound or noise otherwise specified for activity taking place prior to 10:00 p.m., which shall remain in effect.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance to be published in full text.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.
