Dear Steve:

I hope you are well.

As we discussed at the District 6 meeting, the Valley Hunt Club recently re-submitted its application for a new master plan. Several Planning Commissioners and neighbors have asked me whether the Transportation Advisory Commission will review the proposed master plan before it goes to the City Council.

Although the Planning Commission voted to refer the earlier plan to TAC, it is unclear whether that referral is still binding and it is equally unclear whether staff will bring the new plan to TAC. Moreover, the Mayor recently sent a letter to TAC reporting on the City Council's February 6 discussion regarding advisory commissions. The letter suggests that advisory commissions should seek guidance from the Council when they are considering putting matters on their meeting agendas that might exceed their purpose or function. (I will send you a copy of the Mayor's letter.)
