SUBJECT: SCHEDULE OF TAXES, FEES, AND CHARGES

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Approve the scheduled rate increases per the attached Schedule of Taxes, Fees and Charges; and

2. Adopt a resolution establishing a Construction Tax rebate for each affordable dwelling unit included in a building complying with the Green Building Practices Ordinance (PMC Chapter 14.90) effective with the adoption of the 2006-2007 Schedule of Taxes, Fees and Charges.

BACKGROUND

Section 1.08.060 of the Pasadena Municipal Code provides that all taxes, fees and charges referred to in the Code, will be adjusted on July 1 of each year to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) during the 12 months which ended the preceding March 1. Pursuant to California Government Code Section 53750, the City Council has the authority to increase taxes pursuant to a CPI adjustment formula that was in place prior to November 6, 1996. The City's CPI formula was adopted in 1978. The Municipal Code requires the Director of Finance to compute the changes and submit them for review. The Council may reject any or all of the recommended increases; however, it may not modify any adjustments before ordering the report filed. The actions to reject any one of the recommendations must be taken by June 30. At that time, changes that have not been rejected will automatically be implemented. The Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers in the Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County Metropolitan areas increased by 5.12% between March 1, 2005 and March 1, 2006.

The attached list is accordingly submitted showing the current rates of all taxes, fees and charges affected by these provisions, and the adjusted rates that would take effect July 1, 2006. Staff is not recommending changes to any tax rate which is based upon a

percentage because under Proposition 218 these are subject to electoral approval. The 2007 Proposed Grandstand Permit Application Tax, Rose Bowl Admission Tax, and Grandstand Seat Surcharge rates were approved by Council on February 27, 2006. The fee for Relocation Permits Required for Moving Buildings is recommended to be deleted from the Schedule of Taxes, Fees and Charges because the City no longer provides this service. The Fiscal Year 2006 Residential Impact and In-Lieu Fees were approved by Council on October 3, 2005 and January 30, 2006, respectively. These fees will remain unchanged for Fiscal Year 2007 since they have been effective for less than one year, after which they will be adjusted annually by CPI.

On December 19, 2005 the City Council approved recommendations for creating a Green Building Practices Ordinance requiring certain buildings to comply with the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) green building rating system standards. Along with adopting standards, the City Council approved staff's recommendation to establish a construction tax rebate of \$1,000 for each affordable housing unit provided on-site for buildings that meet the requirements of the Green Building Practices Ordinance.

FISCAL IMPACT

Implementation of all scheduled rate adjustments would increase estimated revenues for FY 2007 by the following amounts:

General Fund	\$220,000
Sewer Construction and Maintenance Fund	\$257,000
Library Special Tax Fund	\$80,000

The projected revenue from these increases will be incorporated into FY 2007 Operating Budget if approved by the City Council and have been factored into the City's five year financial plan for illustrative purposes.

Staff estimates construction tax credits to total \$150,000 for the initial eighteen month trial period. No allowance will be given for buildings were the construction tax credit exceeds the total construction tax for the entire building.
