

### Churches on Campus At A Glance

WCIU is a research university. As such, we develop and test theories in the field of International Development. In keeping with our approach of networking with organizations rather than hiring additional staff ourselves, we have attracted to our campus organizations that can field-test our theories within various constituencies.

As we mentioned earlier, most International Development is conducted by non-governmental organizations, which are religious in nature. These NGO's draw staff and financial resources from churches; so, WCIU has invited a number of churches to participate with us to test our concepts.

Each church has a unique ministry focus. These churches vary in size and methodology. Most of their meetings occur on Sundays when the campus is not utilized by the weekday staff and students. Parking is provided on campus parking lots.

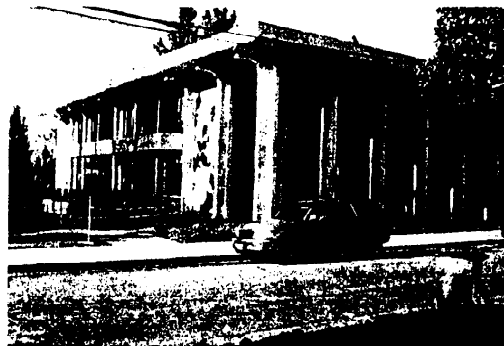
Harvest Rock Church, which had met in our largest auditorium bought Ambassador Auditorium and no longer meets on our campus. However, they maintain their offices here. Consistent with our philosophy of networking with other organizations, we invited another church, Mosaic, to meet in Mott Auditorium.

### **Abundant Life Community Church**

ALCC is a charismatic reformed congregation committed to the team concept of establishing new churches internationally. This church with an attendance of about 200 adults and children is located in La-tourette Library. Its people use the Speer and Aylward parking lots. We are opening our tennis courts for Sunday parking for this church.



### **Lifeline International Christian Fellowship**

Lifeline met on this campus for many years and still maintains their offices here. They are temporarily meeting here on Sunday afternoons while they seek another location to be able to resume Sunday morning services. They conduct weekend classes to train their members to meet human and spiritual needs in other parts of the world.

### **Mosaic**

Mosaic Church is a church of over 1500, with a strong international commitment. Only part of their church meets on our campus. Currently they hold two services Sunday mornings in Mott Auditorium.



They park in the Townsend and Mott parking lots as well as the lot behind the U S Center for World Mission.

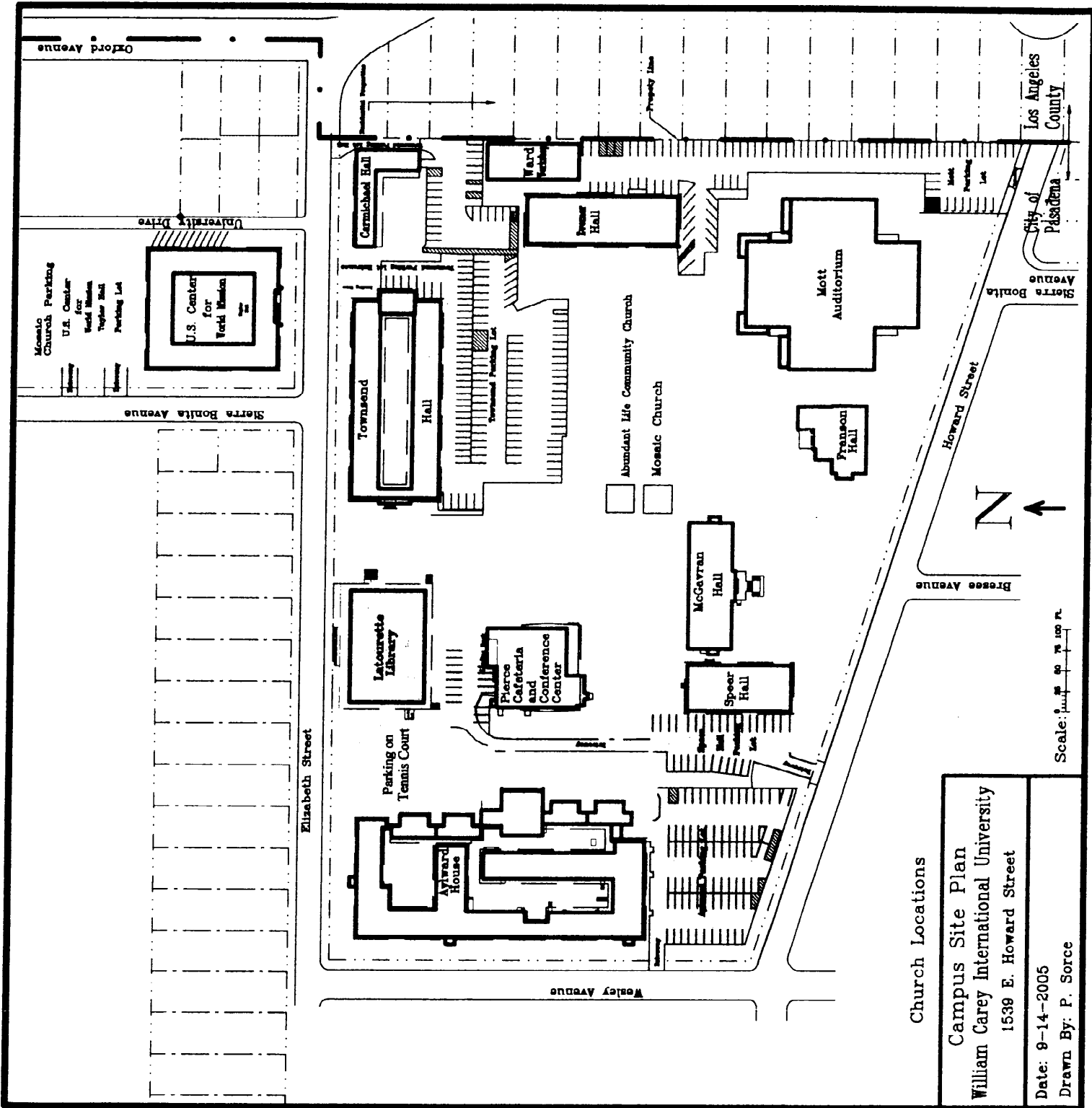

Parking spaces on or immediately adjacent to our campus total 606.



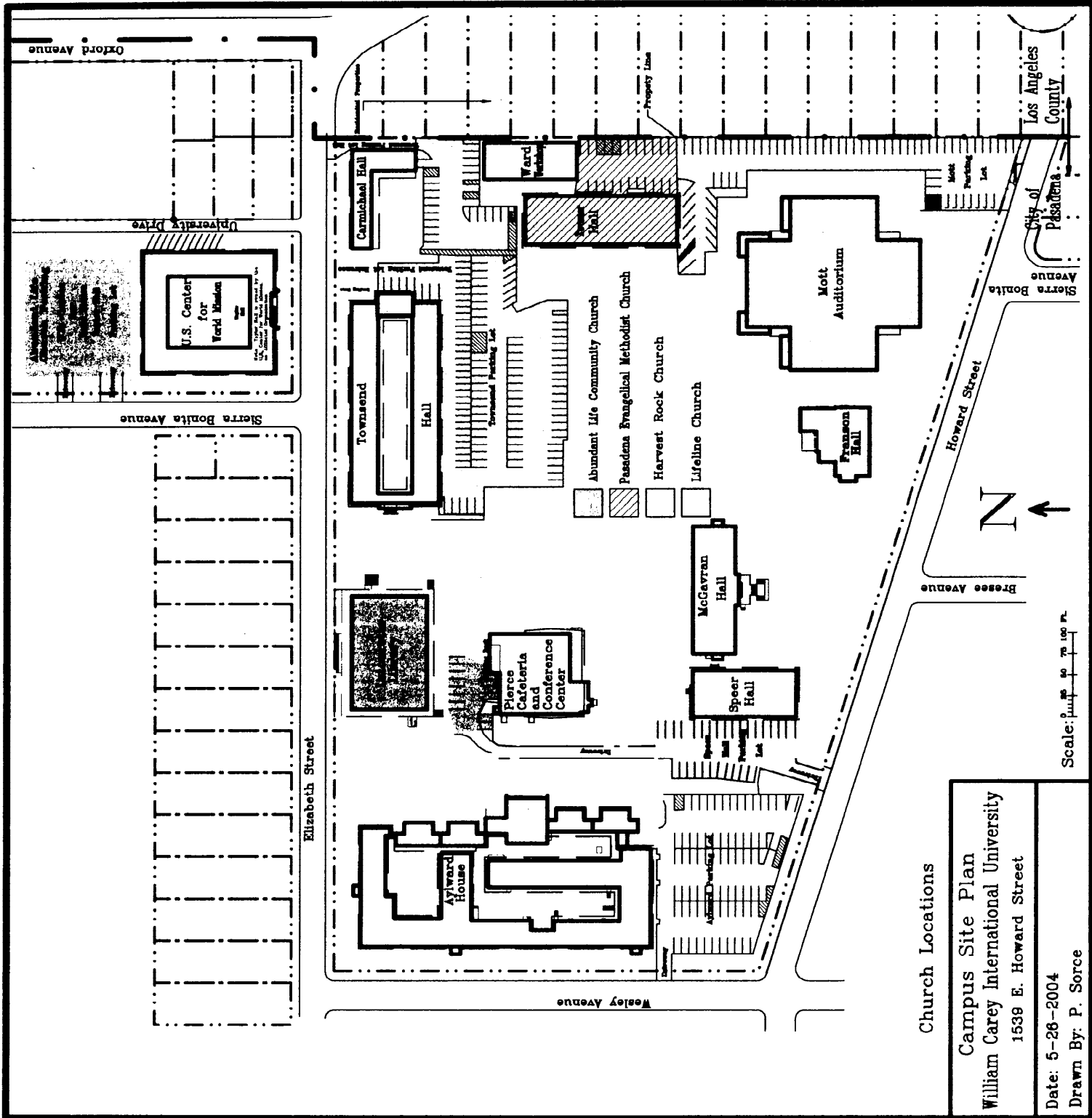
Church Locations

### Other Participating Organizations At A Glance

As was stated in the Operational Philosophy section, many of the functions of the university are out-sourced to other participating organizations on the campus. Most of these participating organizations have a limited focus. WCIU does not staff these organizations. Rather, we invite people and organizations that already have a focus for something in which we need their help.

From time-to-time, their needs and our needs change. Participating organizations come and go either at their request or ours. But, our philosophy remains constant – we deliberately out-source some of the functions of the university to other organizations.

Some of these participating organizations are focused on particular peoples of the world and they provide research and training opportunities for students. Others are in effect part of the International Student Program on campus. Some function as our placement department while also assisting graduates of other schools who wish to invest themselves fully in other cultures. We invite some organizations to participate with us in order to disseminate our ideas on international development to constituencies that we might not otherwise be able to reach.

We have our own publications department and some of the participating organizations also have publications focused on international development. Printing and photocopying needs are addressed both by WCIU directly and by participating organizations and so is housing for staff and students. We out-source audio/visual and travel services also.

### Ethnic Focus Organizations

Some of these participating organizations are focused on particular peoples of the world and they provide research and training opportunities for students.

- **The Institute for Japanese Studies** does research on the Japanese peoples in the US and other countries where Japanese reside. The IJS disseminates information to churches, pastors, missionaries, and students.
- **Operation Ezekiel**, on the other hand, provides a focus on Israel and the Jewish people for WCIU students and other researchers. They educate local churches about Israel, the Jewish people, and the MiddleEast Arab/Israeli conflict, and, by the way, deplore the “conversion” of Jews into Christians. Specifically, they focus on Israeli Jews in greater LA.
- **Chinese Foundation Ministries** adds a vital dimension to the university since at this time the university does not yet have a department of Chinese studies. Its resources on China are available to all students both on and off campus.

### International Student Program

Some other participating organizations are in effect part of the International Student Program on campus.

- **Intercultural Missions Institute** trains Korean university students in English, US culture and international development. From classrooms to dormitory and cafeteria, their students are an integral part of the campus.

### Placement

Still other participating organizations function as our placement department while also assisting graduates of other schools who wish to invest themselves fully in other cultures.

- **Go Ye Fellowship**, on the other hand, provides a vehicle for those wishing to work abroad independently and helps them locate funding resources to supplement the lower salaries in developing countries.



### Marketing

We have invited some organizations to participate with us in order to disseminate our ideas on international development to constituencies that we might not otherwise be able to reach.

- **Christian Educators Association International** is a professional association, which provides unique training and resources to teachers throughout North America
  - CEAI provides WCIU with a channel of communication to grassroots elementary and secondary educators.
  - They find significant opportunities here for training and networking as well as the availability of equipment, services and facilities.
- The **Center for Anabaptist Leadership** serves Mennonite church leaders in Southern California.
  - They focus on empowering their local congregations to serve the immigrant world at their doorsteps.
  - The campus provides them with on-campus housing and dining facilities for their conferences in a location convenient to their constituency.
- **Unreached Nations** their focus is individuals and churches within the charismatic and pentecostal traditions.
  - They promote tools and programs developed at WCIU.
  - Their reasons for participating on the campus are:
    - to derive mutual encouragement and support;
    - to have accessibility to personnel and resources;
    - to gain credibility by association; and
    - to have exposure to people interested in serving the neediest peoples in the world.

### **Business Development**

One approach to International Development is to help third-world societies develop family businesses to support themselves and others within their culture.

- **International Interns** trains leaders in developing countries.
  - They help their people develop family businesses.
  - They network with other campus organizations, schools and churches and provide practicum opportunities for WCIU students.

### **Publications**

In addition to our own publications department, some of the participating organizations have publications focused on international development.

**Peridico Inter D** provides publications in Spanish for the North American Hispanic population. They communicate ideas and programs generated by WCIU to North American Latinos.

### **Printing And Photocopying**

Printing and photocopying needs are addressed both by WCIU directly and by participating organizations.

- Many campus organizations have small office copiers for routine, low volume photocopying.
- When they need to access better equipment and services, they can use WCIU's large, sophisticated self-service copiers or engage the services of off-set printing organizations on campus.
  - **Positive Press** handles small to medium size printing.
  - **Trinity Press** has the equipment to run large, complex, printing jobs.
- Both organizations are committed to providing convenient, low-cost printing to WCIU and other campus organizations, as well as other local organizations focused on various aspects of international development.

**Audio/Visual**

The audio/visual functions of the university are also out-sourced.

- **Frontier Media** provides and operates audio/visual equipment for meetings on campus.
- **Versatape** produces educational audio products and assists other participating organizations with their audio duplicating needs.

**Travel**
