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Reporting 2006 CST Results

- The CST results are reported using five performance levels: advanced, proficient, basic, below basic and far below basic
- Percentage of students scoring at the proficient and advanced levels is presented
- The state target: 100% proficiency by year 2013-2014

Summary of 2006 Districtwide Results

- Continued to show a strong student academic growth
- Overall improved test scores Districtwide in English-language arts and elementary math scores, especially at grade 4
- Demonstrated gains higher than both the LA county and the state gains
- Increased significantly students scoring at grade level in writing, especially at grade 4
- Continued to show decrease in students scoring at the lower two performance levels: far below basic & below basic

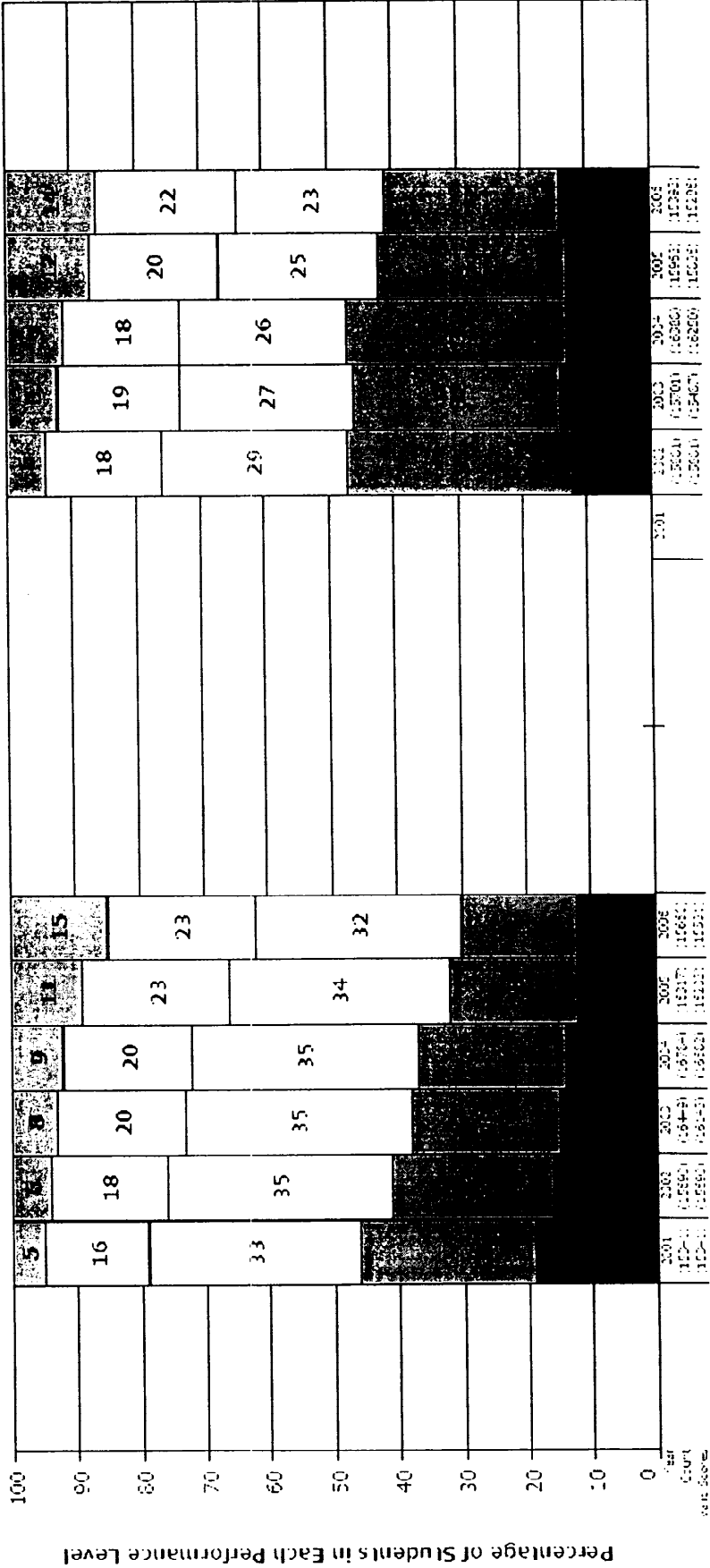
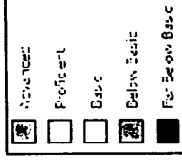

California Standards Test

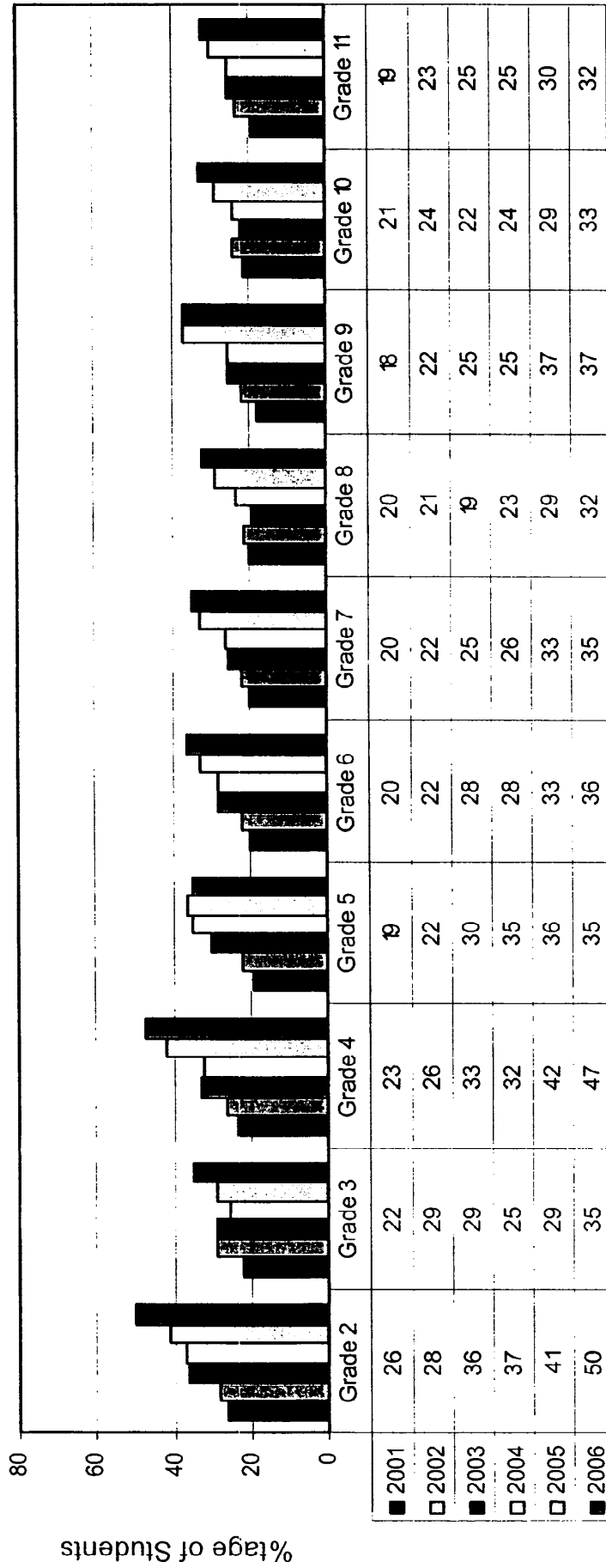

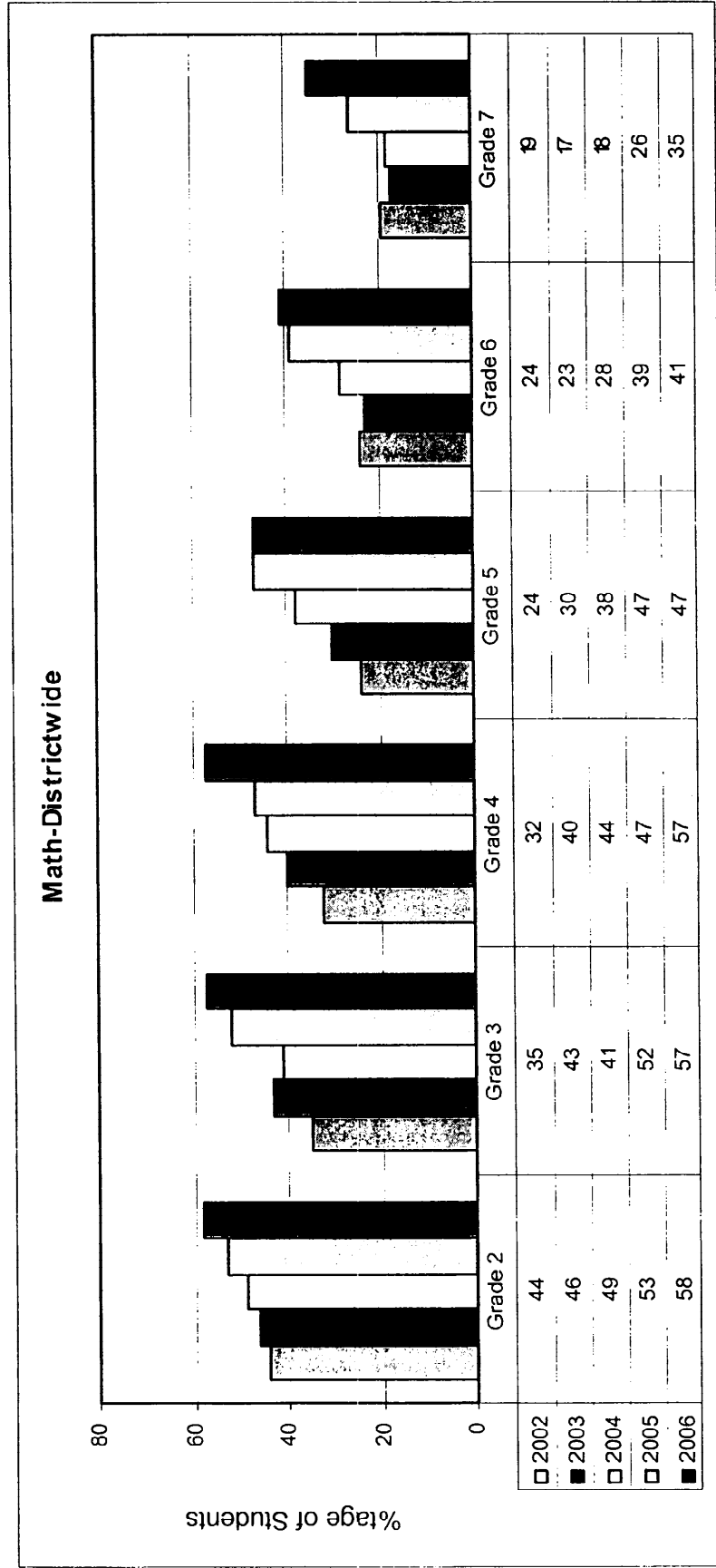

CSTs Districtwide Results: English-Language Arts (ELA)

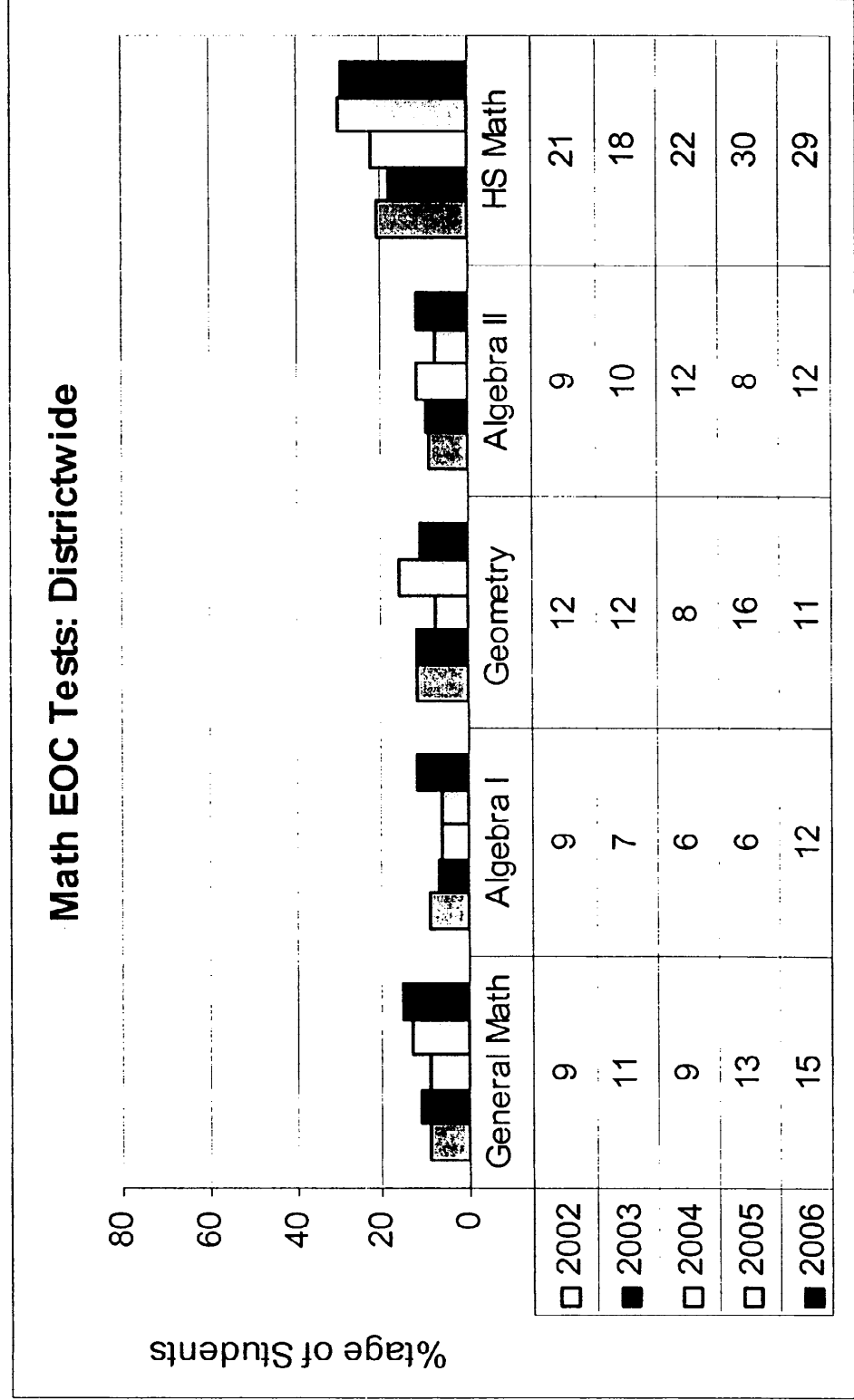
ELA-Districtwide



CSTs Districtwide Results: Mathematics: Grades 2-7



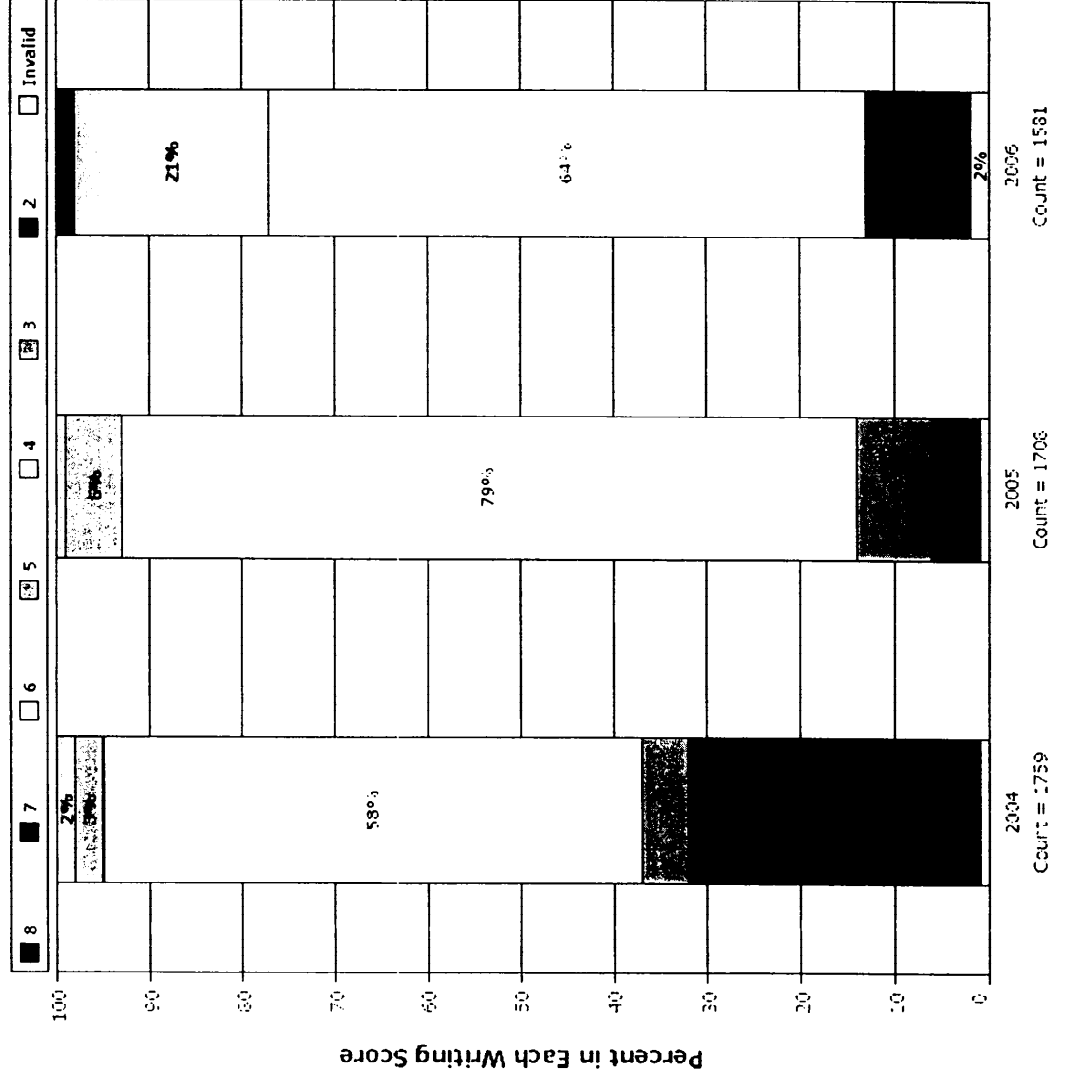
CSTs Districtwide Results: Mathematics End-of-Course (EOC) Tests

California Standards Test



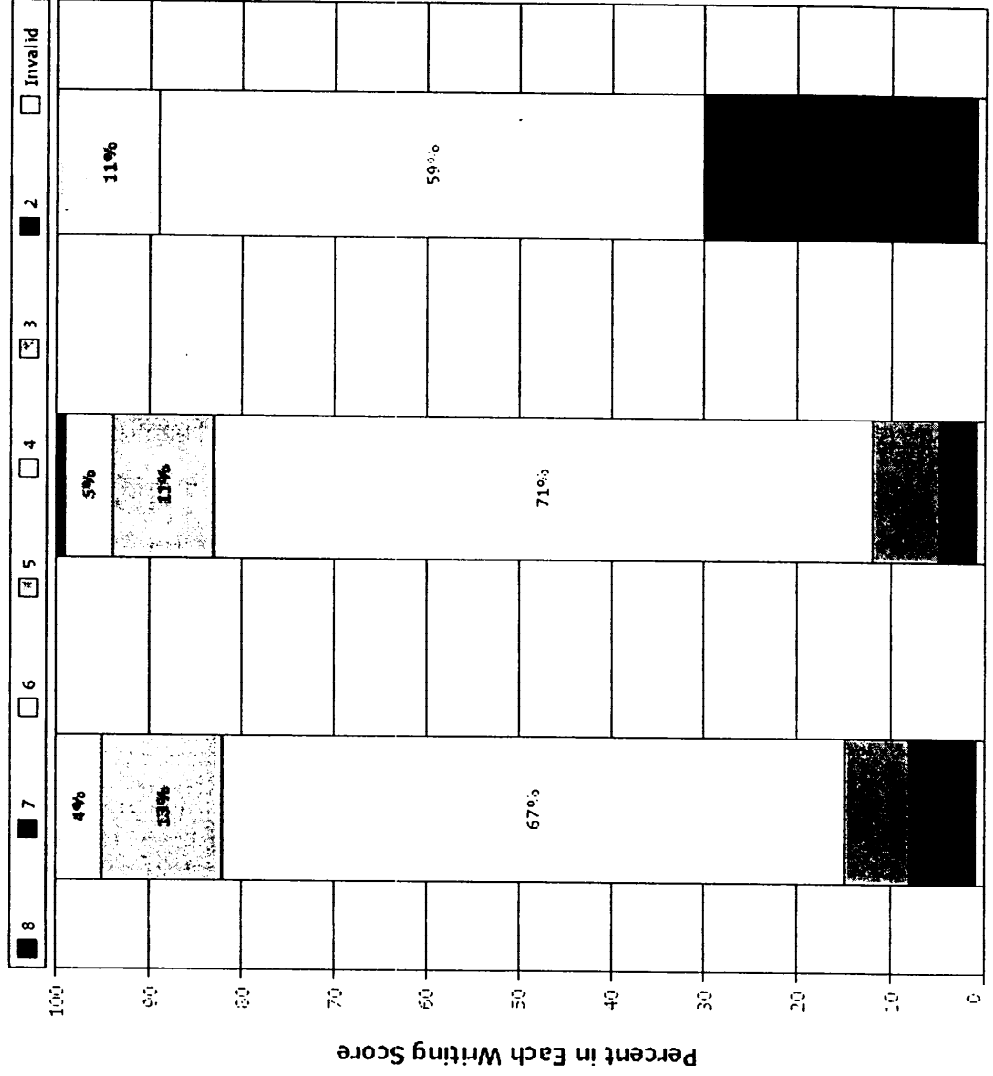

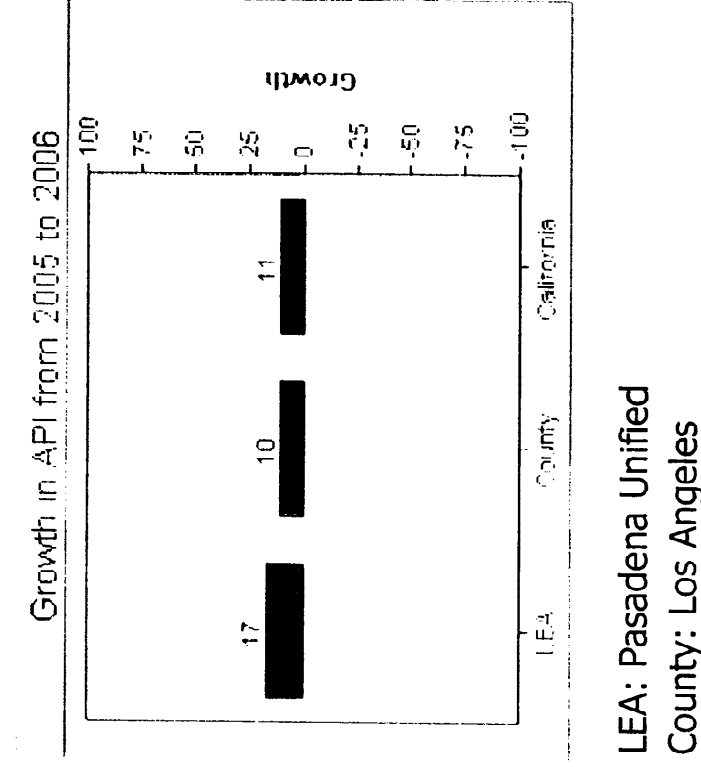
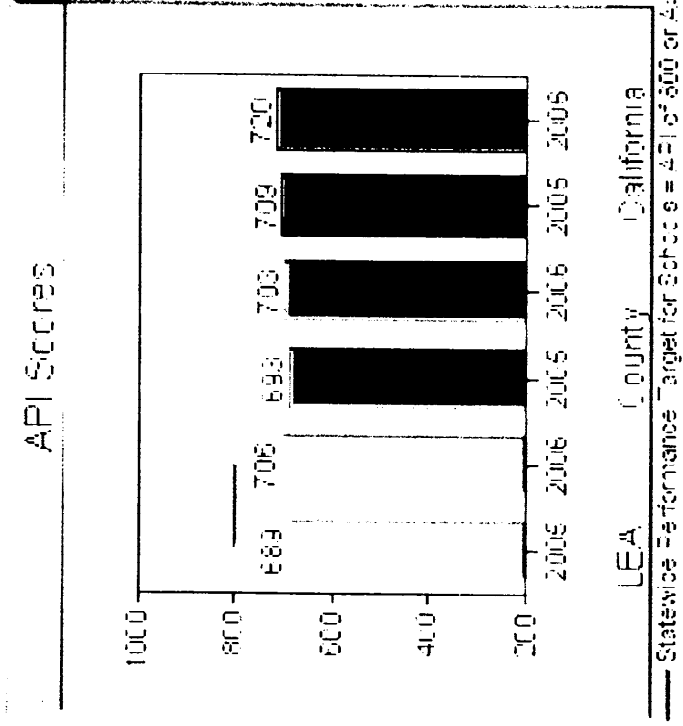

2006 API Growth Comparison



LEA: Pasadena Unified
 County: Los Angeles

- **The District's 17-point API gain is:**
 - higher than both the LA County (10 points) and the state (11 points) gains
 - ranked 1st in the LA County
 - ranked 9th statewide among unified districts with over 15,000 test scores

2006 API score is based on growth.

2006 API Growth Results

- **The District's API score is over 700 in 2006**
- **21 schools** posted an API score **above 700**, including 3 new schools: Madison, Marshall and Pasadena High
- **3 schools** posted an API score **above 800**: Don Benito (852), Willard (837), Norma Coombs (814)
- 24 schools showed improvement in their schoolwide API
- 16 schools met all API targets including their subgroups
- 22 schools showed a double digit growth
 - Hamilton (48 points), Willard (47 points), Norma Coombs (43 points), Rose City High (49 points), Marshall (36 points)
- No PUSD schools with an API score below 600 in 2006, except for Nia Charter (-45 points)
