AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING CHAPTER 4.04 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE (DISPOSITION OF SALVAGE AND SCRAP PROPERTY) BY AMENDING SECTION 4.04.075 (TRANSFER OF SALVAGE PROPERTY TO PASADENA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT) TO STREAMLINE THE TRANSFER OF SAID SALVAGE PROPERTY BY GIVING FIRST PRIORITY TO THE PASADENA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT.

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 4.04.075 of the Pasadena Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“4.04.075 Transfers of salvage property to Pasadena Unified School District.

The director of finance, with the written approval of the city manager, shall give first priority for transfer of salvage property to the Pasadena Unified School District, which may be without city council authorization and of any dollar value. Such transfer may be accomplished by written acceptance by the superintendent of schools of the Pasadena Unified School District certifying that the salvage property specifically described in the written acceptance will further the programs of the District and will not be sold.”

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause this ordinance to be published in full text.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.
