SUBJECT: PUBLIC HEARING - FY 2008-2012 RECOMMENDED CAPITAL

IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGET

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Open the public hearing on the City Manager's Recommended FY 2008-2012 Capital Improvement Program Budget;
- 2. Continue this public hearing to each subsequent meeting of the Council at 7:30 PM until April 30, 2007 or such other later date as the City Council may determine, and at which time the City Council will be asked to close the public hearing and formally adopt the FY 2008-2012 Capital Improvement Program Budget; and
- 3. Refer the City Manager's Recommended FY 2008-2012 Capital Improvement Program Budget to the Finance Committee and direct the meetings be noticed as joint meetings between the Finance Committee and the City Council from April 9, 2007 to April 30, 2007.

BACKGROUND

The City of Pasadena Charter requires that the proposed FY 2008-2012 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) budget for the upcoming fiscal year be submitted to the City Council. As part of the process of adoption, the City Council is requested to formally open the public hearing on the recommended Capital Improvement Program Budget and continue the public hearing weekly until the recommendation to adopt the FY 2008-2012 CIP is presented by the Finance Committee to the City Council.

The CIP budget identifies funding for major capital improvement projects throughout the City's infrastructure. The FY 2008 budget contains 330 projects with a total estimated cost of \$1,575,689,313, and a total recommended appropriation of \$77,108,550 to 115 projects as outlined on Attachment A. In addition, a total of 21 new projects have been added.

Copies of the Recommended FY 2008–2010 CIP have been placed in all the public libraries and in the City Clerk's office. The CIP hearings with the Finance Committee will begin on April 9, 2007, will continue on April 16, 2007, April 23, 2007, and are scheduled to conclude on April 30, 2007. Following the review by the Finance Committee, a final recommended Capital Improvement Program Budget is scheduled to be presented to the City Council for adoption on April 30, 2007, or shortly thereafter. The schedule for the Finance Committee's review of the CIP is listed below.
