SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO PARKS SUBJECT TO RESIDENTIAL IMPACT FEE

TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING TITLE 4 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE TO UPDATE THE LIST OF PARKS AND OPEN SPACE AREAS ON WHICH RESIDENTIAL IMPACT FEES MAY BE EXPENDED

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE

This ordinance implements and codifies the amendments to Title 4 of the Municipal Code approved by the City Council on September 25, 2006. This ordinance required extra time for preparation of the park map drawings.

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED

This legislation is needed to add certain parks and open space to those which the Municipal Code authorizes the expenditure of residential impact fees, as well as to correct certain park drawing references. No particular improvements are approved at this time.

PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENTS OR GROUPS AFFECTED

The Public Works Department will implement the proposed ordinance through construction of park improvements.

FISCAL IMPACT

There will not be an immediate fiscal impact as a result of this amendment to the Municipal Code.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING TITLE 4 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE TO UPDATE THE LIST OF PARKS AND OPEN SPACE AREAS ON WHICH RESIDENTIAL IMPACT FEES MAY BE EXPENDED

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. This ordinance, due to its length and corresponding cost of publication will be published by title and summary as permitted by Section 508 of the Pasadena City Charter. The approved summary of this ordinance is as follows:

"SUMMARY

This proposed ordinance will amend Title 4 of the Pasadena Municipal Code to update the list of parks and open spaces on which the residential impact fees may be expended, and corrects certain map numbers and references. Corrected versions of the maps are attached to the full text of the ordinance and are on file in the City Clerk's Office.

Ordinance No. ______ shall take effect 30 days from its publication."

SECTION 2. Title 4, Chapter 4.17, Section 4.17.060, Subsection D of the Pasadena Municipal Code is amended to read:

"D. Grant Park as depicted on Drawing No. 358<u>5</u>3;"

SECTION 3. Title 4, Chapter 4.17, Section 4.17.060, of the Pasadena Municipal Code is further amended to read:

"O. <u>Lower</u> Arroyo Seco as depicted on Drawing No. <u>5697</u>; from the south city limits to Devil's Gate Dam depicted as follows:

1. Lower Arroyo as depicted on Drawing No. 3575.

2. Brookside south of Seco Street as depicted on Drawing No. 3586.

- 3.— Rose Bowl and adjacent areas as depicted on Drawing No. 3589.
- 4. Brookside Golf Course and Clubhouse as depicted on Drawing No. 3735.
- 5. Other portions as depicted on Drawing No. 3736.
- P. <u>Central Arroyo as depicted on Drawing No. 5698;Oak Grove Park as depicted on</u> Drawing No. 3731.
- Q. Hahamonga Watershed Park as depicted on Drawing No. 5699;
- <u>RQ</u>. Robinson Park as depicted on Drawing No. 3576;
- SR. Villa Parke Center as depicted on Drawing No. 3579;
- <u>TS.</u> Carmelita Park as depicted on Drawing No. 3581;
- \underline{UT} . La Pintoresca as depicted on Drawing No. 3783;
- \underline{VU} . Allendale Park as depicted on Drawing No. 3784;
- <u>W</u> \forall . Any school ground park which is the subject of a cooperative agreement between the City and the Pasadena Unified School District regarding hours of operation and

shared responsibility for maintenance and liability;

"XW. Eaton Wash Viña Vieja Park as depicted on Drawing No. 5700 4715."

"Y. Hamilton Park as depicted on Drawing No. 3592."

"Z. Mediterranean Gardens as depicted on State of California R/W Map No. F1534-4 07 LA-7-31.6."

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause this ordinance to be published by title and summary.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days from its publication.
