AUTHORIZE PURCHASE ORDER WITH PASADENA FORD

FOR PURCHASE OF EIGHT NEW POLICE VEHICLES FOR A

TOTAL OF \$192,355

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1) Authorize the issuance of a purchase order to Pasadena Ford in an amount not to exceed \$192,355 for the purchase of eight 2007 Crown Victoria police vehicles: and
- 2) Grant the proposed purchase order an exemption from competitive bidding pursuant to City Charter section 1002(H), contracts with other governmental entities or their contractors for labor, material, supplies or services.

BACKGROUND

Due to the unique nature of its operations, the Police Department requires specialized vehicles designed to handle the demands of the job and built to protect drivers. Staff has written specifications for a dedicated heavy-duty police package. The life cycle of police patrol vehicles is three years, and for detective vehicles is six years. The proposed purchase of eight sedans will replace vehicles that have met or exceeded their useful life cycles. The vehicle replacement/condition reports are attached.

The City of Long Beach currently has a contract in place with Pasadena Ford for the purchase of Crown Victoria Police Interceptors over a period of three years. Pasadena Ford has offered to extend this contract price to the City of Pasadena for eight police interceptors due for replacement in FY2008. Purchasing the requested vehicles from Pasadena Ford would be in the City's best interest because it would expedite the delivery of the vehicles, thus reducing the time needed to place the vehicles in service; it will also save the City approximately

\$695 per vehicle in price increases for model year 2008 for a total savings of \$5,560.
