SUBJECT: CONTRACT AWARD TO ACEY DECY LIGHTING FOR THE

INSTALLATION OF A LIGHTING DIMMER CONTROL SYSTEM IN

THE PASADENA CIVIC AUDITORIUM

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

Authorize the Pasadena Center Operating Company to enter into a contract with Acey Decy Lighting to install an ETC Dimming System at the Pasadena Civic Auditorium for an amount not to exceed \$152,000.00. The contract amount includes a 10% contingency of \$14,000.

BACKGROUND

The Pasadena Civic Auditorium's current dimmer system was installed in 1974. The system no longer meets the needs of the users of the Civic Auditorium and has made it more difficult to attract events. The system is also becoming unreliable and the availability of parts and service has all but disappeared. This system has reached the end of its useful life and needs to be replaced. The specified replacement system represents the current industry standard and will fully accommodate the needs of the users of the Civic Auditorium.

Competitive bids were solicited on the lighting system. Four proposals were received. All bids were reviewed for responsiveness and technical merit. The lowest responsive proposal was submitted by Acey Decy Lighting.
