**RE:** CANVASS OF THE MARCH 6, 2007 CONSOLIDATED PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION AND SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

## RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council:

(1) Accept the Certificate of Canvass.

(2) Adopt a resolution declaring:

(a) The following persons, receiving a majority of the votes cast, are re-elected to the following offices:

Bill Bogaard  
Steve Haderlein  
Steve Madison

Mayor of the City of Pasadena  
Member of the City Council, District 4  
Member of the City Council, District 6

(b) In District 1, the following two candidates received the highest number of votes at the primary nominating election, and their names shall be placed on the ballot at the general municipal election on April 17, 2007:

Jacque Robinson	559 votes (28.6%)	District 1
Robin Salzer	565 votes (28.9%)	District 1

(c) In District 2, the following two candidates received the highest number of votes at the primary nominating election, and their names shall be placed on the ballot at the general municipal election on April 17, 2007:

Jim Lomako	543 votes (28.2%)	District 2
Margaret McAustin	845 votes (44.0%)	District 2

(d) The result of votes cast for Measure C, an ordinance extending and amending Chapter 4.109 of Title 4 of the Pasadena Municipal Code, the Library Special Tax, are as follows:

**BACKGROUND:**

The City of Pasadena held its Primary Nominating Election on Tuesday, March 6, 2007, for the office of Mayor and for members of the City Council, Districts 1, 2, 4 and 6. Pasadena City Charter Section 1204 provides that "Any person who, at the primary election, shall receive a majority of the total vote cast for candidates for said office shall be elected to such office."

At the Primary Nominating Election, Mayoral candidate Bill Bogaard received a majority of votes from voters within the City of Pasadena and was re-elected as Mayor for a full term of four years. City Council District 4 candidate Steve Haderlein and District 6 candidate Steve Madison each received the majority of votes from their districts and were re-elected as members of the City Council, Districts 4 and 6, respectively.

In the Council District 1 race, of six candidates running for this office, no one received a majority of the total votes cast. The two candidates with the highest number of votes are Robin Salzer (28.9%) and Jacque Robinson (28.6%) and, in accordance with Charter Section 1204, only their names shall appear on the general municipal election ballot for District 1 office.

In the Council District 2 race, of three candidates running for this office, no one received a majority of the total votes cast. The two candidates with the highest number of votes are Margaret McAustin (44.0%) and Jim Lomako (28.2%) and, in accordance with Charter Section 1204, only their names shall appear on the general municipal election ballot for District 2 office.

Measure C, referenced above, submitted to City of Pasadena voters and requiring two-thirds approval, passed with 80.4% voting in favor and 19.5% voting in opposition.

Pursuant to Article VII of the Pasadena City Charter, the Primary Nominating Election for members of the Board of Education, Seats 2, 4 and 6, was consolidated with the City Primary Nominating Election. The official canvass results for the Pasadena Unified School District election are submitted directly to the Board of Education.


**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The total cost of this consolidated election will be shared pro rata by the City of Pasadena and the Pasadena Unified School District, based on a formula to be established by the Registrar of Voters Office. The cost of this election will be tabulated upon receipt of all invoices, and the School District will be invoiced by the City for its pro rata share of costs.



There will be a consolidated general (run-off) election on April 17, 2007 for Council Districts 1 and 2, and Board of Education Seats 2 and 4. Since there will be a run-off election for both the City and the Pasadena Unified School District, the cost of the April 17, 2007 election will be shared by the City and the School District, based a pro rata formula.

**RESOLUTION NO.**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PASADENA DECLARING THE RESULTS  
OF THE CITY'S CONSOLIDATED PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION  
AND SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION  
HELD ON TUESDAY, MARCH 6, 2007**

WHEREAS, a Primary Nominating Election for the office of Mayor and a District Primary Nominating Election for members of the City Council in Districts 1, 2, 4 and 6 of the City of Pasadena was called by the City Council to be held on March 6, 2007, to be consolidated with the Pasadena Unified School District Primary Nominating Election for Board of Education Seats 2, 4 and 6, to be held on said date; and

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election was called by the City Council, to be held in conjunction with the above-referenced consolidated Primary Nominating Election to be held on March 6, 2007, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the City of Pasadena an ordinance extending and amending Chapter 4.109 of Title 4 of the Pasadena Municipal Code, the Library Special Tax, subject to the approval of two-thirds of the votes cast by voters voting on the proposal within the City of Pasadena; and

WHEREAS, the votes at said consolidated Primary Nominating Election and Special Municipal Election have been canvassed by the City Clerk and a copy of said canvass is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, said City Clerk has certified the results of said canvass to the City Council of the City of Pasadena.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pasadena that:

1. The following be declared to be the results of the Primary Nominating Election for the office of Mayor and members of the City Council, Districts 1, 2, 4 and 6:

2. That Bill Bogaard, having received a majority of the total votes cast for candidate for the office of Mayor of the City of Pasadena, from which the candidate sought nomination, hereby is declared to be re-elected as Mayor for a full term of four years.

3. That Steve Haderlein, having received a majority of the total votes cast for candidate for the office of member of the City Council from District 4, from which the candidate sought nomination, hereby is declared to be re-elected as a member of the City Council from District 4 for a full term of four years.

4. That Steve Madison, having received a majority of the total votes cast for candidate for the office of member of the City Council from District 6, from which the candidate sought nomination, hereby is declared to be re-elected as a member of the City Council from District 6 for a full term of four years.

5. That Jacque Robinson and Robin Salzer, being the two persons receiving the highest number of votes in District 1, shall be the candidates for election by District 1 at the City's general municipal election on April 17, 2007.

6. That Jim Lomako and Margaret McAustin, being the two persons receiving the highest number of votes in District 2, shall be the candidates for election by District 2 at the City's general municipal election on April 17, 2007.

7. The following be declared to be the result of the votes cast for Measure C, submitted to the voters of the City of Pasadena at the consolidated Special Municipal Election held on March 6, 2007:


**MEASURE C**

Shall the ordinance imposing a "Library Special Tax" be extended which: (1) can only be used exclusively to fund a portion of operational costs of the Central and branch libraries; (2) exempts religious facilities, community service organizations and persons meeting certain income criteria; (3) limits annual increases based on the Consumer Price Index; (4) prevents imposition of Tax if certain General Fund commitments to the Library are not made; and (5) contains a fifteen-year limit?


