**SUBJECT:** CONTRACT AWARD TO INSITUFORM TECHNOLOGIES, INC. FOR 2007 RELINING OF STORM DRAIN FACILITIES IN ROSEMEAD BOULEVARD FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$259,000

## **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the City Council accept the bid, dated April 17, 2007, submitted by Insituform Technologies, Inc. for the 2007 Relining of Storm Drain Facilities in Rosemead Boulevard, reject all other bids received, and authorize the City Manager to enter into such contract not to exceed \$259,000.

## **BACKGROUND**

The project calls for the installation of 311 feet of pipe liner inside the existing corrugated metal storm drain pipe in Rosemead Boulevard, as shown in Exhibit 'A'. This location was identified during a Los Angeles County Department of Public Works storm drain inspection. The liner is being installed to rehabilitate the invert of the pipe to prevent future voids and to eliminate ponding of storm water. Rehabilitation of the pipes will be accomplished with the insertion of pipe liner via the manholes. There is no excavation required for this process, so the inconvenience to the public will be minimal. This project is consistent with the Land Use Element by continuing to implement capital improvements which will maintain or rehabilitate existing infrastructure.

The Department of Public Works prepared Specifications for the subject project. In accordance with Section 4.08.070 of the Pasadena Municipal Code, bids have been requested and received. The project was advertised in the Pasadena Journal on February 22, 2007. Bid packets were obtained by fourteen contractors, four of whom submitted bids for the project.

The following advertising bids were opened on April 17, 2007 and are as follows:

The discrepancy between the Engineer's Estimate and the lowest bid received is due to increased costs of materials for the large diameter pipe. The diameter of the existing corrugated metal pipe varies from 54" to 72," and is much larger than previous storm drain relining projects that was the basis for the cost estimate.

It is recommended that Insituform Technologies, Inc. be awarded the contract for this project as they are the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The proposed contract with Insituform Technologies, Inc. fully complies with the Competitive Bidding and Living Wage Ordinances. The Contractor has indicated that the award of this contract will result in zero new hires to his present workforce.

The proposed contract will be set up as follows:



It is anticipated that the project will begin in June 2007 and be completed in July 2007.


**FISCAL IMPACT**

Funds for this project are available in Capital Improvement Budget Account 76473, Preventative Maintenance – CMP Storm Drain.






