SUBJECT: MEMBERSHIP OF THE HAHAMONGNA WATERSHED PARK ADVISORY COMMITTEE

TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING CHAPTER 2.100 OF TITLE 2 CONCERNING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE HAHAMONGNA WATERSHED PARK ADVISORY COMMITTEE

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:

The Hahamongna Watershed Park Advisory Committee ("the Committee") was created in 1997 and is currently made up of the members of the Recreation and Parks Commission, two members of the Northwest Commission and two members of the Environmental Advisory Commission. In 2000, the membership of the Recreation and Parks Commission was reduced from 11 to 9 by Ordinance No. 6820; however, the size of the Committee was not changed to reflect the reduction. The purpose of this ordinance is to reflect the resulting change in membership requirements for the Committee from 15 members to 13 members.

REASON WHY THIS LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:

Pursuant to Section 410 of the City Charter, the City Council has authority to modify the organization of city operations by amendment of the Pasadena Municipal Code. This ordinance is necessary for consistency in municipal code provisions as a result of the change in size of the Recreation and Parks Commission.

This ordinance will affect the Recreation and Parks Commission and the membership and quorum requirements of the Committee.


FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

There are no fiscal impacts from this amendment.


POLICY CHANGE:

This amendment is a clerical change needed to reflect a March 2000 reduction in the members of the Recreation and Parks Commission who also serve on the Committee.



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING CHAPTER 2.100 OF TITLE 2 CONCERNING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE HAHAMONGNA WATERSHED PARK ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Title 2, Chapter 2.100, Section 2.100.120 (A) of the Pasadena Municipal

Code is amended to read:

“2.100.120 Hahamongna Watershed Park Advisory Committee.

A. There is created a thirteen-member (13) Hahamongna Watershed Park Advisory Committee composed of the nine (9) members of the commission, two (2) members of the northwest commission and two (2) members of the environmental advisory commission. The northwest commission and the environmental advisory commission shall designate the members of their respective bodies to serve on this advisory committee.”

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall take effect upon the date of its publication.


