Figure 3-3 – Central District Pedestrian-Oriented Use Areas

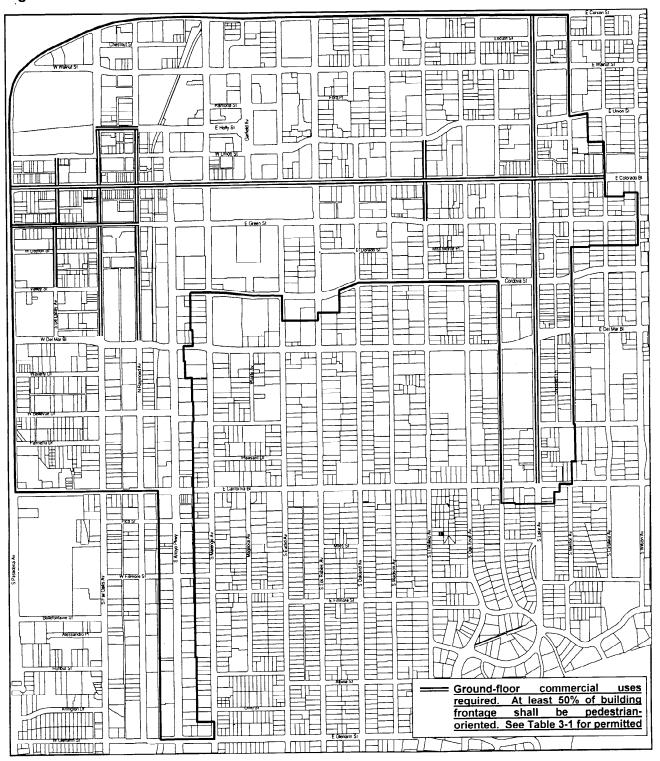
