

FISCAL IMPACT:

As set forth in the Agenda Report dated June 14, 2010, funding to cover this increase in reimbursement will be allocated from the underground utility surtax fund. It is estimated that approximately 150 property owners will take advantage of the reimbursement during FY 2011, with a projected cost of \$450,000.



ORDINANCE NO.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING
SUB-SECTION 13.14.110C OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL
CODE RELATING TO UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICTS**

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Title 13, Chapter 13.14, Section 13.14.110, Subsection C of the Pasadena Municipal Code is hereby amended to read:

“C. Upon completion and approval by city of such undergrounding of electrical utilities as is required by subsection A of this section, the City shall pay the property owner of each separately recorded property the lesser of either three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) or the actual cost of the work in accordance with procedures established by the city manager.”

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.
