SUBJECT: CONTRACT AWARD TO WALKER RESTORATION CONSULTANTS FOR

GARAGE ASSESSMENT SERVICES ON CITY-OWNED GARAGES

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Find that the project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Article 19, Section 15306 in accordance with Section 21084 of the Public Resources Code; and
- 2. Authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with Walker Restoration Consultants to assess the physical conditions of nine City-owned garages in an amount not to exceed \$126,000.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Pasadena owns nine parking structures in the downtown area. The oldest of these structures were built in 1970, while the newest were built in 2003. An assessment of the physical conditions of these garages is needed to correct any deficiencies and prolong the useful life of the structures.

On April 27, 2010, the Department of Transportation released a Request for Proposals (RFP) to solicit proposals for the services of a Parking Structure Assessment firm to assess the physical conditions of nine City-owned parking structures in Pasadena. A total of five proposals were received and evaluated by a review panel. (See Attachment A.)

Based on review of the selection criterion, Walker Restoration Consultants was awarded the highest score. The firm has extensive experience in the maintenance and assessment of parking garages and was selected because of prior successful completion of projects with similar scope for other garages. It is recommended that Walker Restoration Consultants be awarded the contract.

Funds for this contract will be drawn from the Old Pasadena Tax Increment encumbered by the Old Pasadena Capitol Improvement Project. There are sufficient funds in budget account number 8164-805-452147-73935 for this contract.
