Pasadena Mayor, Honorable Bill Bogaard, and Pasadena City Council

Pasadena Roving Archers has reviewed the proposal and recommendations released by the City on Thursday and we are in agreement with the exception of recommendation #4.

Recommendation #4 is vaguely written and appears to be inconsistent with recommendations #1-#3 and #5 and so at this time we can not offer our support of it.

With respect to the terms of the agreement we continue to believe that:

- requiring archers to have taken a safety class and obtained a certification for use of the range during periods of public use
- encoding the range rules in the Pasadena Municipal Code such that they are readily enforceable
- relocating the targets that have been removed from private property onto city property
- improving the barriers and signage consistent with the Lower Arroyo Master Plan
- removing the ad hoc trail that runs adjacent to the target bales between the bales and the archers' shooting positions

will ensure that archery on this historic range can continue safely and in harmony with other users of the Arroyo.
