TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

AN UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA APPROVING A DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PASADENA AND PPP OFF 100 WEST WALNUT, LIMITED PARTERSHIP, RELATED TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF A MIXED-USE OFFICE CAMPUS AND RESIDENTIAL COMMUNITY IN THE AREA BOUNDED BY WEST WALNUT STREET, FAIR OAKS AVENUE, WEST UNION STREET AND NORTH PASADENA AVE

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE

On this same date, the City Council of the City of Pasadena will be asked to approve a Development Agreement between the City of Pasadena and PPF OFF 100 West Walnut LP for the mixed use office campus and residential project on the parking lots of the Parson's site. The Development Agreement must be approved by an uncodified ordinance

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED

The California Government Code (Section 65864, et seq.), sets forth the required elements of a development agreement, and the process by which a development agreement is approved. Section 65867.5 requires that development agreements be adopted by ordinance as a legislative act. Adoption of this ordinance fulfills that requirement.
