^{*} This 5-year goal was not met due primarily to the bankruptcy of PNHS in early-2012. PNHS administered, on behalf of the City, a homeowner rehabilitation program utilizing federal HOME and CDBG funding. After nearly two years, the program did not become available until FY 2014 when the City awarded a \$250,000 HOME sub-recipient contract to NHS of LA County to rehabilitate up to 9 homes. By that time, the City's HOME allocation from HUD had been cut back nearly 50%.

^{**} This 5-year goal was based primarily on market-driven Inclusionary housing production. The Great Recession significantly impacted residential development in Pasadena and, as a consequence, the production of Inclusionary units fell short of the projected goal.
