SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO FISCAL YEAR 2017 ADOPTED BUDGET

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Find that the proposed action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") in accordance with Section 15061(b)(3), the General Rule that CEQA only applies to projects that may have an effect on the environment and;
- 2. It is recommended that the City Council amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 Adopted Budget as detailed in the Background Section of this report.

BACKGROUND:

Each fiscal year budget amendments are presented to City Council for its review and approval to account for changes to the adopted budget. Typically at the beginning of a fiscal year, staff will bring forward a request to carry forward funds from the previous fiscal year to the current year in order to fund expenditure commitments in the form of purchase orders and contracts that were not fully paid in the previous fiscal year. The proposed amendments represent previously approved expenditures from the FY 2016 budget that were unexpended as of June 30, 2016 and are anticipated to be expended during FY 2017.

Staff is requesting a total of \$2,033,044 from various funds be carried forward to the FY 2017 budget. Of this amount, \$432,420 will carry forward to the General Fund. The Finance Department has verified there is sufficient fund balance in the various funds for these expenditures.

COUNCIL POLICY CONSIDERATION:

The City Council's strategic planning goal of maintaining fiscal responsibility and stability will be advanced through monitoring the FY 2017 Adopted Budget and by implementing necessary amendments.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of the recommended budget amendments will increase FY 2017 total authorized operating appropriations across multiple funds by \$2,033,044. This amount will be set aside in the Assigned Fund Balance of the various funds and will be noted in the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report as of June 30, 2016. The carried forward amounts will not affect the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the various funds in FY 2017.
