AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 3, CHAPTER 3.24, SECTION 3.24.110(A)(8) RELATING TO CAMPING IN PUBLIC PARKS AND FACILITIES AND TITLE 12, CHAPTER 12, SECTION 12.12.080 RELATING TO OBSTRUCTING A PUBLIC WAY OR PLACE

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

Section 1. Title 3, Chapter 3.24, Section 3.24.110 Prohibited acts, Subsection A8 of the Pasadena Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"3.24.110(A)(8)

~~To camp or lodge in any park or upon the grounds above-specified, except in places designated for such purposes;~~

To camp, erect, maintain, or occupy any tent, lodge, structure, temporary or makeshift shelter, or unattended installation or display in any park or upon the grounds above specified except in places designated for such purposes."

Section 2. Title 12, Chapter 12, Section 12.12.080 of the Pasadena Municipal Code is hereby amended by redesignating text and adding subsections A, B, C, D and E which read as follows:

"12.12.080 - Persons obstructing public way or place.

A. It is unlawful for any person to stand or sit in or upon any street, alley, sidewalk, or crosswalk so as in any manner to hinder or obstruct the free passage of persons passing along the same except as follows: for a use or activity for which a permit has been previously obtained from the city, or for a use under the terms of a valid license agreement with the city, or for viewing a parade or similar event for which a permit has been issued, or for lawful labor activities that are permitted to be carried out by state or federal law, or for activities protected by the California Constitution or the

United States Constitution.

B. It is unlawful for any person to place his/her personal property upon any street, alley, sidewalk, or crosswalk so as, in any manner, to hinder or obstruct any person from freely passing by; such property may be removed from the public way or place by the City if the owner of such property is not present or is unable to remove the property. A notice of such removal shall be given to the owner and or placed at the location from where such property was removed. Such property shall be stored by the City for at least 30 days.

C. It is unlawful for any person to impede the progress of another or to hinder or obstruct any person from freely passing by on any street, alley, sidewalk, or crosswalk, for the purpose of soliciting, asking, or begging for money; or to approach any person in any public way or place in a threatening, coercive or menacing manner for the purpose of soliciting, asking, or begging for money.

D. It is unlawful for any person to sit or lie down in any entrance to a building or to camp, erect, maintain or occupy any tent, lodge, structure, temporary or makeshift shelter, or unattended installation or display upon any street, alley, sidewalk in the Civic Center or on any street, parkway, boulevard, sidewalk or avenue that is located within a "primary commercial corridor" if signs are posted prohibiting such conduct.

E. For purposes of this section:

"Entrance" shall mean the entire area between the outer edge of an entrance to a building and the exterior door and includes the entry way, door way or vestibule.

"Civic Center" shall mean the area bounded by Walnut on the North, Arroyo Parkway on the West, Green Street on the South, and Los Robles on the East.

The following are identified as primary commercial corridors:

Arroyo Parkway between Holly Street and Glenarm Street

California Boulevard between Saint John Ave and Marengo Street

Colorado Boulevard between Orange Grove Blvd and Halstead Ave

Del Mar Boulevard between Saint John Ave and Marengo Street

Fair Oaks Avenue between Montana Street and Railroad Street

Foothill Boulevard between Greenwood Ave and Michilinda Ave
Green Street between Orange Grove Blvd and Hill Street
Hill Avenue between Maple Street and Del Mar Blvd
Holly Street between Garfield Ave and Pasadena Ave
Lake Avenue between Woodbury Street and Oakwood Place
Lincoln Avenue between Montana Street and Chapman Ave
Los Robles Avenue between Maple Street and Del Mar Blvd
Orange Grove Boulevard between Cypress Ave and Mentor Ave
Raymond Avenue between Corson Street and Glenarm Street
Rosemead Boulevard between Sierra Madre Villa Ave and Walnut St
Sierra Madre Boulevard between Maple Street and Mohawk Street
Union Street between Pasadena Ave and Catalina Ave
Walnut Street between Orange Grove Blvd and Rosemead Blvd
Washington Boulevard between Rutan Way and Tierra Alta Drive

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days following its publication.


