TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

AN UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA GRANTING ASSIGNMENT OF NON-EXCLUSIVE SOLID WASTE FRANCHISE FROM RECOLOGY LOS ANGELES TO ARACO ENTERPRISES, LLC., DBA ATHENS ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE

At its meeting on September 18, 2017, the City Council directed the City Attorney to prepare an amendment to Ordinance No. 7306 and authorized the City Manager to enter into the franchise agreement that subsequently approves the transfer and assignment of a non-exclusive solid waste franchise from Recology Los Angeles to Araco Enterprises, LLC., dba Athens Environmental Services. After reviewing such application, it was determined that the application complies with Chapter 8.61 of the Pasadena Municipal Code and the applicant has agreed to comply with all provisions of Chapter 8.61.

REASONS WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED

The charter of the City of Pasadena, Article XI, Section 1104 specifies that the method and procedure for granting a franchise shall be by ordinance.

FISCAL IMPACT

The City will receive a fee of 23.066 percent of gross customer receipts generated by Araco Enterprises, LLC., dba Athens Environmental Services. In FY 2017, Recology Los Angeles' franchise fees totaled \$99,840.

The project has been reviewed for compliance with CEQA and is exempt per Section 15061 (b)(3). The project is covered by the general rule that CEQA only applies to projects that have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment.
