## 2018 Power Integrated Resource Plan Report

A complete copy of the Draft 2018 Power Integrated Resource Plan Report (“IRP Report”) was included as Attachment 1 to the agenda report provided to the Municipal Services Committee (“MSC”) on November 27, 2018. Hard copies of the full Draft IRP Report were also delivered to all other City Councilmembers in the agenda packets for the December 3, 2018 City Council Meeting.

Subsequent to the MSC meeting, the following amendments were made to the Draft IRP Report to provide additional clarity. These changes do not have any material impact on the findings or recommendations on the IRP Report.
