## TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING TITLE 4
OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER 4.42
ENTITLED "TRANSACTIONS AND USE TAX" TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TAX AND FEE ADMINISTRATION, SUBJECT TO
ADOPTION BY THE ELECTORATE

## **PURPOSES OF THE ORDINANCE**

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a 3/4-cent transactions and use tax ballot measure, subject to approval by two-thirds of the City Council, and approval by Pasadena voters at the November 6, 2018 General Municipal Election.

#### REASONS WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED

At its July 16, 2018 meeting, the City Council is being requested to conduct first reading of this ordinance. It will require a second reading on July 23, 2018, and then be submitted to Pasadena voters.

# PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENTS OR GROUPS AFFECTED

Revenues from the transactions and use tax will be deposited into the General Fund.

### FISCAL IMPACT

If the ordinance is approved by two-thirds of the City Council, and a majority of Pasadena voters, annual tax revenues are estimated to provide approximately \$21 million.
