SUBJECT: AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING STATE MODEL WATER EFFICIENT LANDSCAPE ORDINANCE

TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING CHAPTER 17.44 OF THE ZONING CODE (TITLE 17) TO INCORPORATE THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES MODEL WATER EFFICIENT LANDSCAPE ORDINANCE

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE

This ordinance will amend Chapter 17.44 (Landscaping) of the Zoning Code (Title 17) to update City regulations pertaining to landscaping and irrigation standards, and to incorporate the California Department of Water Resources Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance as directed by Council on April 23, 2018.

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED

This legislation is necessary to align Chapter 17.44 (Landscaping) of the Zoning Code with the requirements imposed by the California Department of Water Resources Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance on all cities, including charter cities.

PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENTS OR GROUPS AFFECTED

The Planning and Community Development Department will implement this zoning code amendment.
