## TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA REPEALING CHAPTER 13.22 (WATER EFFICIENT LANDSCAPE) OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO WATER EFFICIENT LANDSCAPE

### PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE

As directed by the Council on April 23, 2018, this ordinance will repeal Chapter 13.22 (Water Efficient Landscape) of the Pasadena Municipal Code so as to avoid duplication with proposed amendments to Chapter 17.44 (Landscaping) of the Zoning Code (Title 17) to update City regulations pertaining to landscaping and irrigation standards, and to incorporate the California Department of Water Resources Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance.

### REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED

This legislation is necessary to clean up and align the Pasadena Municipal Code with the requirements imposed by the California Department of Water Resources Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance on all cities, including charter cities.

This ordinance will not take effect until the same date that the companion ordinance amending Chapter 17.44 takes effect.
