SUBJECT: ADOPT A

ADOPT A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AMENDED BYLAWS OF

THE PASADENA CENTER OPERATING COMPANY

RECOMMENDATION:

- Find that the recommended action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality
 Act ("CEQA") pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), the general
 rule that CEQA only applies to projects that may have an effect on the environment;
 and
- Adopt a Resolution approving the proposed amendments to the Pasadena Center Operating Company Bylaws.

BACKGROUND:

On April 16, 2018, the City Council formed the Pasadena Tourism Business Improvement District ("PTBID") and appointed the Pasadena Center Operating Company ("PCOC") Board as the Owners' Association under Streets and Highways Code Sections 36612 and 36651. The PCOC Board met on September 26, 2018 and approved changes to the PCOC Bylaws to reflect that the PCOC Board has been designated as the Owners' Association for the newly formed PTBID. The Board additionally approved minor changes in the Bylaws to make them consistent with Pasadena Municipal Code Chapter 2.165 and to reflect the Board practice of referring to the President as the Chair and the Vice President as the Vice Chair.

With approval of the proposed changes, the Bylaws and the PCOC practice will be consistent with the PCOC Board being designated as the Owners' Association for the PTBID and the Bylaws will conform to actual practice. A highlighted copy showing the proposed changes is attached.
