SUBJECT: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PORTIONS OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 17 (ZONING CODE) RELATED TO SEXUALLY ORIENTED BUSINESSES

TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 17 (ZONING CODE), CHAPTERS 17.50, 17.60, AND 17.80 TO UPDATE DEFINITIONS AND REGULATIONS FOR SEXUALLY ORIENTED BUSINESSES

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE

This ordinance amends various portions of Pasadena Municipal Code ("PMC") Title 17 (Zoning Code) related to regulation of sexually oriented businesses to modernize regulations thereof. The ordinance will update definitions and regulations for sexually oriented businesses.

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED

In February, the City Council adopted revisions to PMC Chapter 5.45 (Sexually Oriented Businesses) to update and modernize the City's regulation of sexually oriented businesses, as it had been thirteen years since the City reviewed and updated its Municipal Code provisions regulating sexually oriented businesses. This update to the Zoning Code is necessary to align it with the changes to Chapter 5.45. This update to the Zoning Code does not change any regulations regarding where sexually oriented businesses may locate within the City.


ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION
