AGREEMENT EXPIRES JUNE 30, 2020

 AGREEMENT HAS BEEN IN PLACE EFFECTIVE 1995

 RBOC IS PROVIDED AUTHORITY IN THE AGREEMENT TO ACT AS CITY'S AGENT TO MANAGE THE STADIUM AND GOLF COURSES

OPERATING AGREEMENT BACKGROUND

 ENABLES RBOC TO ENTER INTO EVENT AGREEMENTS AS WELL AS OTHER CONTRACTUAL COMMITMENTS

 POLICIES AND RULES BY WHICH THE RBOC MUST CONDUCT ITS BUSINESS ARE OUTLINED IN THE AGREEMENT ACTION BEING REQUESTED WOULD EXTEND THE AGREEMENT BY 3 YEARS UNDER THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS EXIST TODAY

 AN EXTENSION IS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE RBOC CONTINUED AUTHORITY TO MANAGE CITY ASSETS

- RBOC BUSINESS MODEL FACING SIGNIFICANT CHALLENGES
 - > REBOUND FROM COVID-19 PANDEMIC
 - UNCERTAINTY WHEN STADIUM WILL BE ABLE TO OPERATE AS IT DID PRE-COVID
 - ATTENDANCE IMPACT WHILE PANDEMIC IS ONGOING IS ALSO UNCERTAIN
 - > SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA IS THE MOST COMPETITIVE STADIUM MARKET IN UNITED STATES
 - > VERY RELIANT ON TENANTS SUCCESS JADENA

NEED TO CONTINUE TO WORK CLOSELY WITH TENANTS (TOURNAMENT OF ROSES, UCLA, MUSIC FESTIVAL, FLEA MARKET, GOLF) TO MAXIMIZE SUCCESS FOR ALL PARTIES

- > GOLF INDUSTRY CHANGING RAPIDLY
- > INCREMENTAL REVENUE CRITICAL FOR RBOC TO ATTAIN SUCCESS

- DURING NEXT 3 YEARS RBOC WILL WORK CLOSELY WITH CITY STAFF TO DETERMINE WHAT CHANGES MAY BE NECESSARY TO ENABLE RBOC TO SUCCEED AND REPORT BACK TO COUNCIL
 - CHANGES COULD INCLUDE FINANCIAL TERMS, EVENT MIX, PHYSICAL IMPROVEMENTS, APPLICABLE REGULATIONS
- FOR THE FORESEEABLE FUTURE THE RBOC RECOMMENDS QUARTERLY REPORTING TO COUNCIL FINANCE COMMITTEE AND CONTINUED CLOSE COOPERATION BETWEEN CITY STAFF, AND RBOC STAFF EN A
